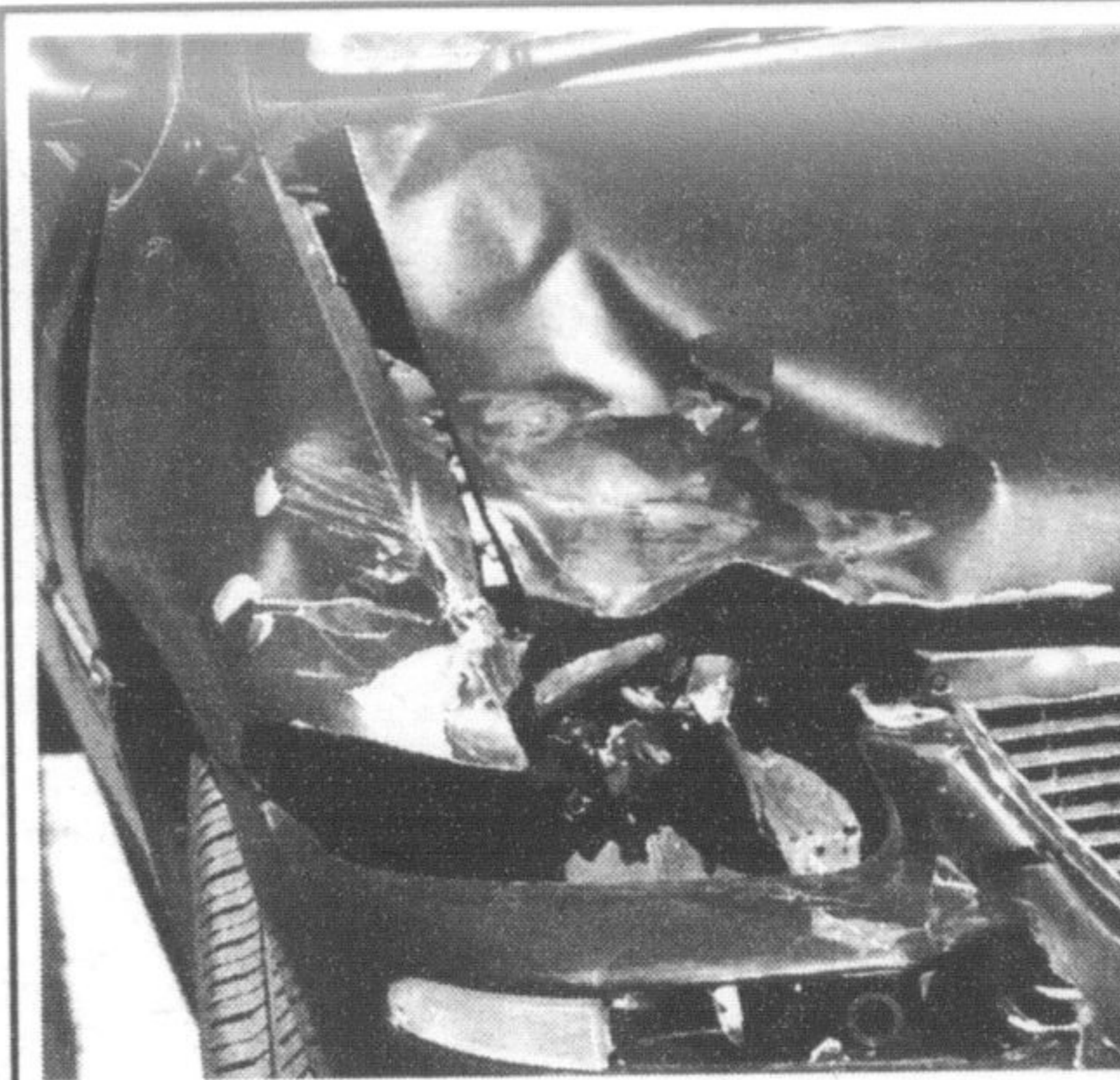




Eye on the ball

Football, v-ball officials needed

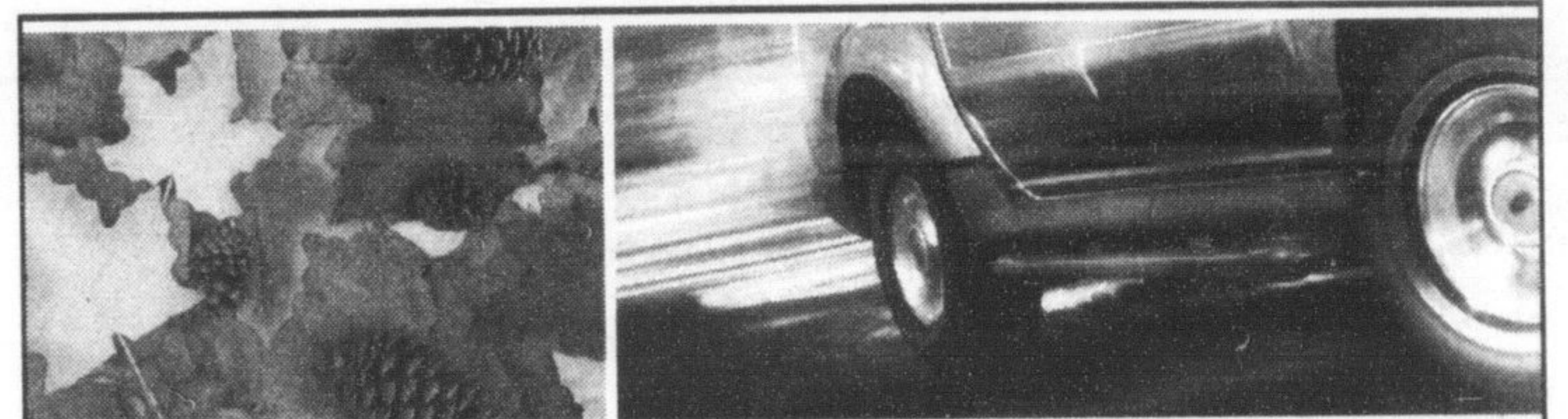

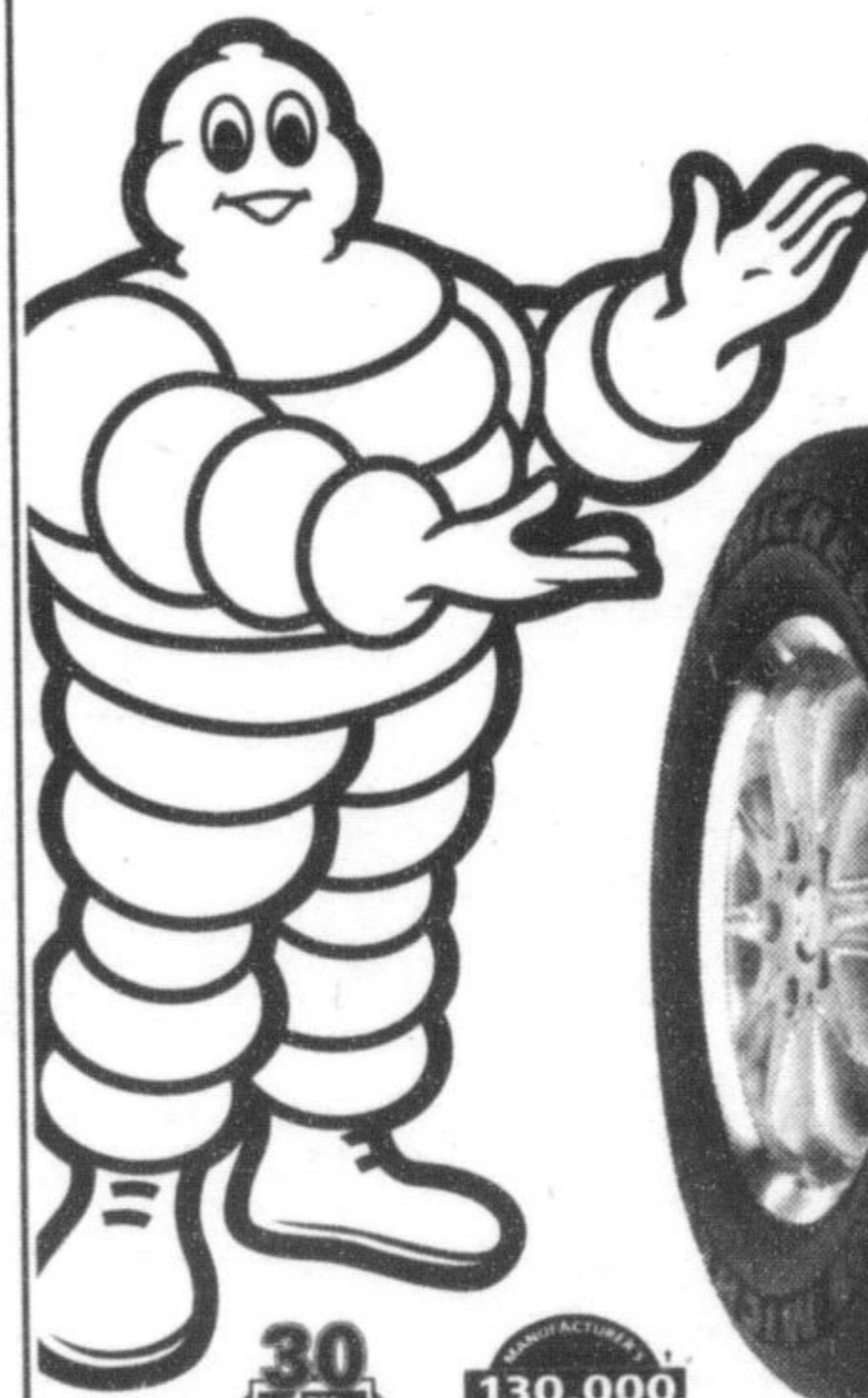
