## Notice of Public Meeting

## Proposed Business Licensing By-law

As required by the *Municipal Act*, 2001, the Town of Milton will hold a public meeting to outline and receive input on the proposed business licensing by-law on Monday, November 15, 2004 at 7:30 p.m. in the Council Chambers at Town Hall.

The Town proposes to license the following businesses:

- Personal service businesses including acupuncture, hair cutting, manicure and nail treatments, electrolysis, aesthetics, tattooing and micro-pigmentation, body piercing, and ear piercing
- Pawnbrokers
- Transient traders including day sales, seasonal sales, door to door sales, antique/collectible shows, craft shows, manufacturing shows, and flea markets
- Commercial refreshment vehicles including catering trucks, ice cream trucks and bikes, yoghurt and juice carts, hot dog carts and chip trucks
- Auctioneers
- Salvage yards
- Second hand dealers
- Food sales
- Kennels


