Yard Waste Tips

Urban Yard Waste is collected every other week on the same day as your Blue Box from April until December. For exact dates check your Curb Appeal Calendar.

Acceptable items include:

- yard and garden trimmings, pumpkins, fallen fruit from trees and tree trimmings.



Unacceptable items include:

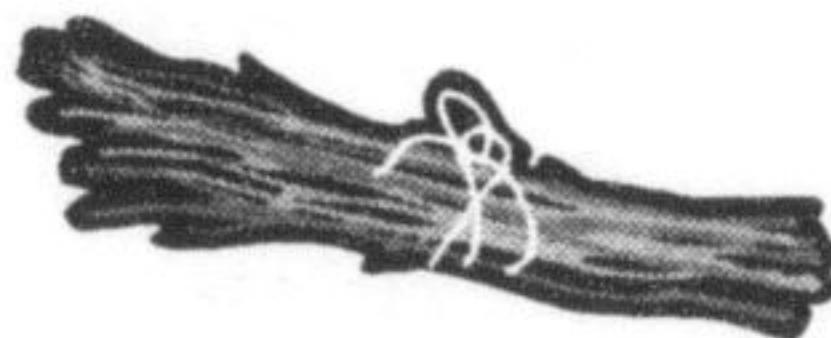
- grass clippings, tree stumps, sod, soil and rocks.

Here are some tips for setting out your yard waste:

- Use **open**, reuseable, rigid containers such as a bushel basket or a garbage can (tip - drill holes in the bottom of your garbage can for drainage).
- Place a yard waste sticker on your **open**, reuseable container to identify that it is yard waste. Labels are available at no charge by calling Halton Region at 905-825-6000, Toll Free: 1-866-4HALTON (1-866-442-5866).
- Use paper yard waste bags to handle the overflow during high volume times.



Brush must be tied in bundles no larger than 1.2 m (4 ft) long by 0.6 m (2 ft) wide, with branches a maximum of 7.5 cm (3 inches) in diameter.



Note: Yard waste placed out in plastic bags or cardboard boxes will not be collected.



Yard waste placed out in decorative plastic Halloween bags will not be collected.
