"I see FASM growing by leaps and bounds," he said.

For residents who don't know much about FASM, Mr. Repchuk said: "FASM is a mechanism by which people can show-case their talent."

He went on to explain that this is accomplished through art shows and exhibitions such as their yearly studio tour. There are regular seminars and workshops, as well as smaller specialty groups that meet during the week to hone their crafts.

It's for artists of any type who want to belong to an artistic community, he said.

Although his days are full, and 'bored' isn't a word in his vocabulary, Mr. Repchuk said his community involvement — he's also an Arts Milton director and member of the Burlington Fine Arts Association, among other groups — doesn't become tiring because it's what he loves to do.
