

Town council adopts new business licensing bylaw

Milton council adopted a new business licensing bylaw last week, setting out regulations local store entrepreneurs will have to follow.

The updated document covers personal service businesses, pawn brokers, travelling vendors (like door-to-door sales), commercial refresh-

ment vehicles, auctioneers, salvage yards, second-hand dealers, food sales and kennels.


Prior to last week amendments, personal services and pawn brokers were not licensed in Milton.

Other changes include the requirement for

door-to-door sales people to provide a criminal record check and salvage yards to refuse goods from those 16 years old and younger.


Also, kennel licensing has been taken out of the animal control bylaw and added to the business licensing bylaw.

Kennels will have to have six-foot fences, up from the previous four-foot requirement, and the Town will have to check for cruelty convictions with the Oakville and District Humane Society before issuing a licence.

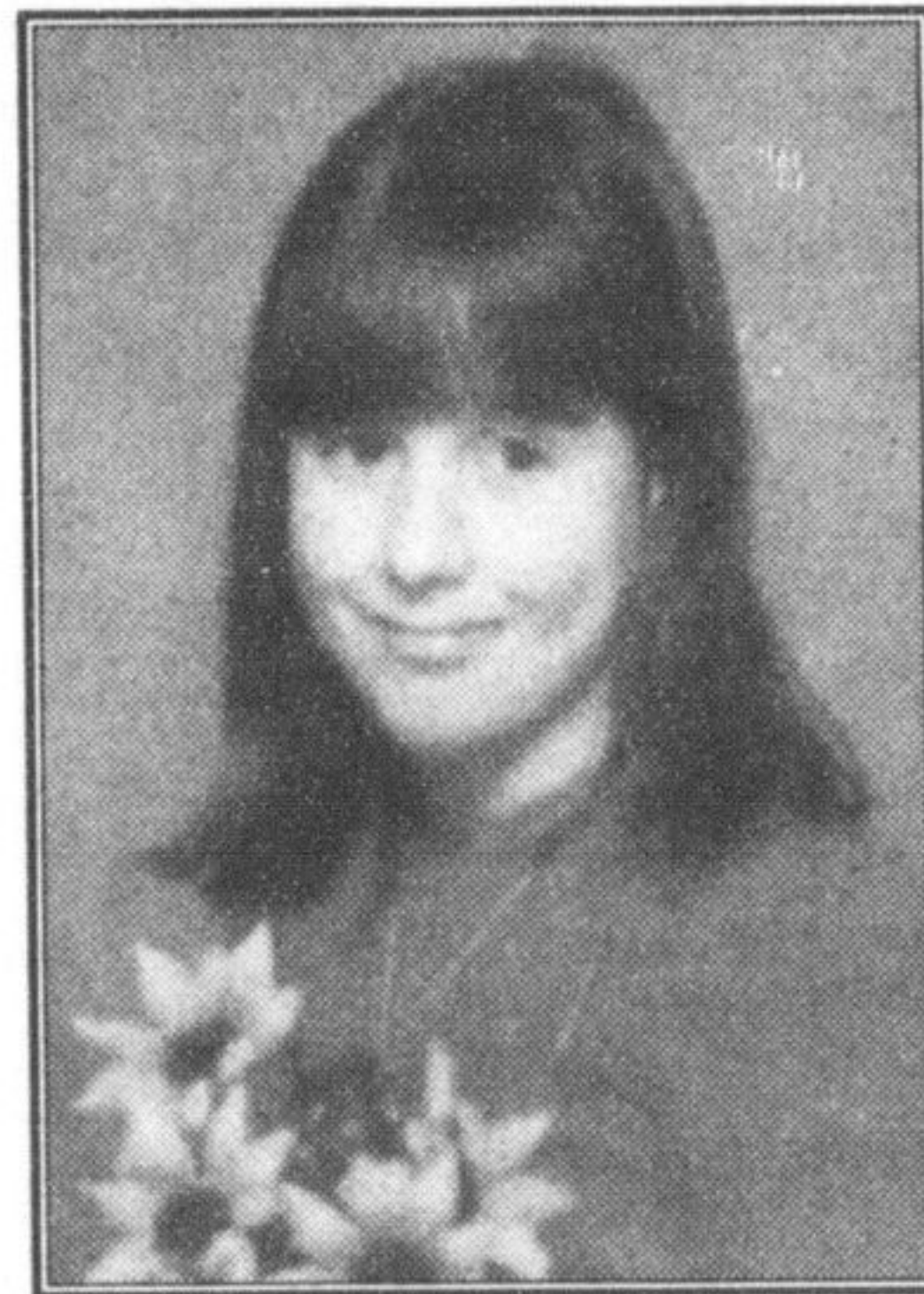

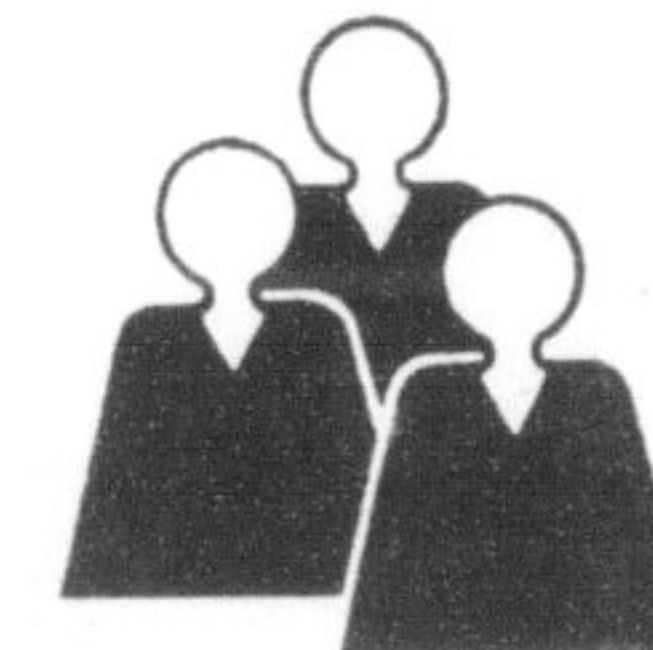
