

Having already walked over the rebuilding E.C. Drury Spartans twice this season, the Royals will have an opportunity to make it a clean sweep of the hometown opposition when they host MD in regular season-ending action February 15.

Before that the two teams resume play on February 8, when BR travels to Acton and MD hosts Georgetown's Christ the King.

Andrew Smith tallied twice and added an assist, while Christian Pinheiro contributed a goal and two helpers.


Also scoring was J.J. Stimson.
