3 per cent tax hike approved

Green light given after minor revisions

After a couple small revisions, Milton council approved the Town's operating budget Monday night with a three per cent tax increase.

This means the average urban homeowner will pay an extra \$17.89 — based on a \$250,000 assessment — or 34 cents more per week, and those in the rural area will pay \$14.76 more, or 28 cents extra a week.

The budget committee met before a special council meeting to look over the numbers put forward by staff, with Ward 4 Councillor John Challinor being the only one to suggest any cuts.

He made a motion to take \$118,000 allocated to transit for September to December out of the operating budget, but it garnered little support from his fellow councillors.

The money would be used to create a fourth transit route through the new parts of town and out to the Milton Crossroads shopping centre.

Mr. Challinor said he'd like to see this expense delayed until there's a sense of where transit ridership is going.

"I'm not very pleased, quite frankly, with the take up at this point," he said.

He added his priority would be to bring the tax increase down to two per cent, noting he targeted reducing the \$1-million transit budget in the last four months of the year to achieve lower taxes because it wouldn't significantly impact the service.

But, Ward 3 Councillor Jan Mowbray said she had strong reservations about changing the transit program.

"I shudder to think if we do anything to it now what it will become," she said.

Ward 4 Councillor Wendy Schau noted that in order to attract more ridership, the system has to be expanded.

"It needs to be convenient for people to use," she said.

Director of Corporate Services and Treasurer Jim McQueen said Mr. Challinor's suggested change would mean a tax increase slightly over two per cent. But, the motion lost.

Mr. Challinor also proposed that the mayor and council professional development budget be brought down from the \$2,000 proposed and set at \$1,000 and each councillor's public relations budget be set at \$200, instead of the suggested \$250, which received support from council.

He explained this motion was borne out of principle, not concern about the size of the expenditures.

"Taxpayers should not be expected to finance the training of those elected to serve as councillors on Milton council," he said of the professional development budg-

The \$500 cut from the councillors' public relations budget was returned to the mayor's budget.

"The mayor is council's chief political representative in the community and all Town public relations or 'gifting' should be co-ordinated through his office," Mr. Challinor said.

"If an individual councillor wants to present something to a local resident, business or organization, that should be done through the mayor's office, or that councillor should pay for the gift out of his or her
