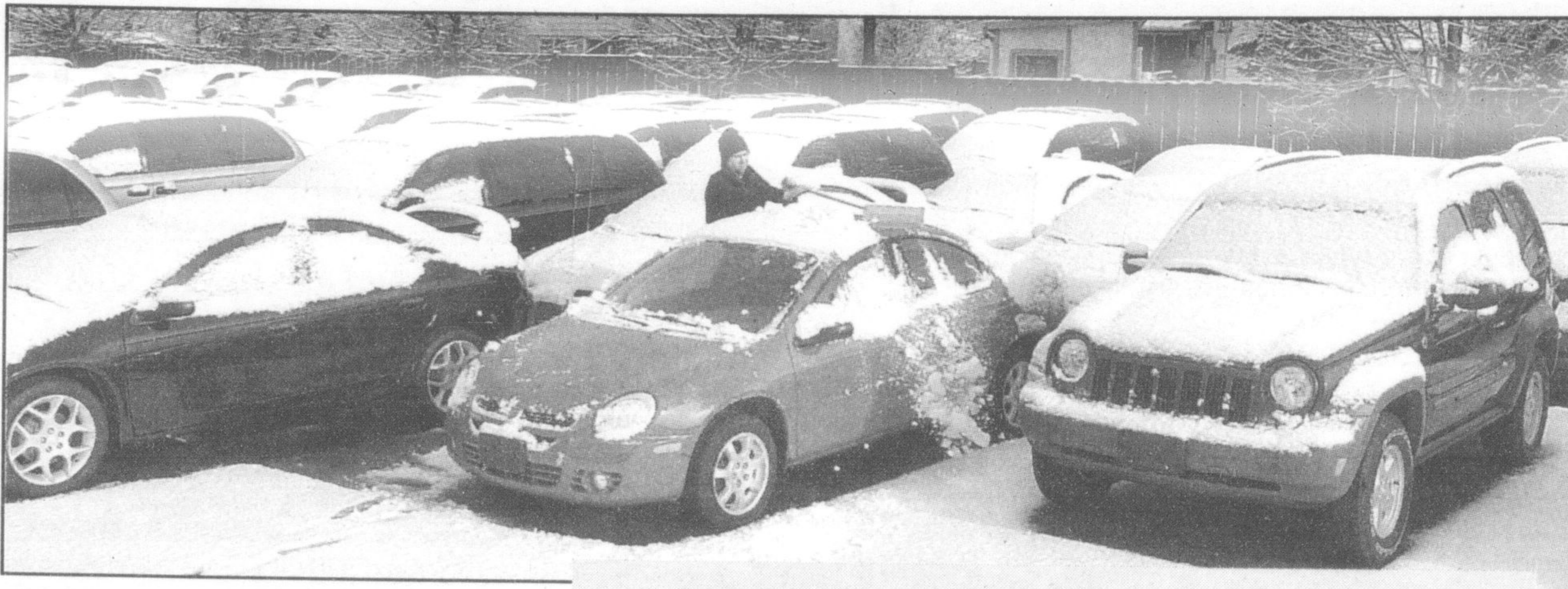

Cash infusion for cops

A cheque for almost a million dollars is being presented today to the Halton Regional Police Service.

The service is to receive \$863,278 as part of the provincial government's Community Policing Partnerships program.

"Community safety is a major priority of the McGuinty government," said Oakville MPP Kevin Flynn, who is to present the cheque. "We are committed to giving

police the tools necessary to do their job better and safer. I am pleased to be able to present the cheque to help the Halton Regional Police Service and the Regional Municipality of Halton in its effort to reduce crime."

Under the Community Policing Partnerships grant program, the Province is paying 50 per cent of the cost for 43 front-line police officers the Halton service has hired as part of the program.
