When people pray, God listens. But talking to God can be intimidating for some. People often ask me: "How can I pray better?"

Jesus' disciples posed a similar question to Him as recorded in Matthew 5. Commonly called "The Lord's Prayer", it serves as a model for all believers to follow.

Another approach that you may want to consider incorporates the use of five fingers in one hand to serve as reminders of how to pray.

. Your Thumb is nearest to you. So

remember. To pray for our loved ones is, as C.S. Lewis once said "sweet duty."

- 2. The next finger is the Pointing Finger. Pray for those who teach, instruct and heal. This includes teachers, doctors, and ministers. They need support and wisdom in pointing others in the right direction. Keep them in your prayers.
- 3. The next finger is the Tallest Finger. It reminds us of our leaders. Pray for our Prime Minister, our parliamentarians, our senators, our Mayor and the many leaders at the forefront of businesses, industries, places of commerce, administration and public service. LUTHERA These people shape our nation and guide public opinion. They need God's guidance.
- 4. The fourth finger is our Ring Finger. Surprising to many is the fact that this is our weakest finger, as any piano teacher will testify. It should remind us to pray

begin your prayers by praying for those for those who are weak, in trouble or in closest to you. They are the easiest to pain. They need your prayers day and night. You cannot pray too much for them.

> 5. And lastly comes our Little Finger, the smallest finger of all, which is where we should place ourselves in relation to God and others. 
