

Inquest into inmate's death set for April 11

An inquest will be held next month into the death of a Maplehurst inmate who died at Milton District Hospital last year.

Dr. Karen Acheson, regional supervising coroner for central west Ontario, has announced that the inquest into the death of Ernesto Borea will begin April 11 at 9:30 a.m. at the Ramada Inn, 155 Chisholm St.

Mr. Borea died July 18, 2004.

The inquest will examine the circumstances surrounding his death, and the jury may make recommendations aimed at preventing similar deaths.

Dr. John Ewen will preside as inquest coroner.

An inquest is mandatory when a person dies while in custody.

The inquest is expected to last three days and will hear from about 17 witnesses.

neers," he said.

"I run a clean business. We have all the people to justify that the materials we bring in meet the specifications."

A notice issued by the MNR last year stated, "The reason for the required amendment to the site plan is to maintain the exposed water table within the limits of the licensed pit and to reduce the amount of off-site materials required to complete site rehabilitation."

But Jonathan Kahn, the lawyer representing Campbellville Sand and Gravel Supply, said he requires a full list of reasons for the proposal to respond to.

"I need to have an explicit, clear, justified set of reasons for this proposal to change a licensee's rights," he said.

Mr. Kahn recently represented Dufferin Aggregates at the hearing of the Ontario

Municipal Board and Environmental Review tribunal on the potential 85-hectare expansion of the Milton quarry. The verdict on this matter has yet to be announced.

If the issues surrounding Campbellville Sand and Gravel can't be resolved at the mediation session, it will go to a full hearing that's scheduled to start July 18 at 10 a.m. in Milton Council Chambers. The mediation will also be held at Town Hall, commencing at 10 a.m.

Last year, the local pit pleaded guilty to charges for tracking mud onto Campbellville Road. Mr. Guerrieri has also had his aggregate licence suspended on several occasions for various reasons, including the type of fill being brought into the site.
