Jesus Christ has conquered death and has given hope to humanity.

About 190 years ago or so, Napoleon was the scourge of Europe. His troops had conquered army after army, and nation after nation. It seemed that soon England too, would fall under the iron fist of the 'Little General'. But in one last desperate effort the British monarchy sent their greatest general, Wellington, onto the continent of Europe to take on Napoleon on the battlefield of Waterloo.

The date was June 18, 1815. A lone watchman stood on the tower of Wincester Cathedral looking out across the English Channel for a semaphore signal to flash them the news of the battle's outcome. The whole future of England hung in the balance of the battle at Waterloo.

News of defeat quickly spread throughout the city. All of the hopes of England were dashed. Soon the French

ENEMY! England was saved - their general had been victorious! Oh, how the message changed with the addition of only two words.

In a few minutes, the good news spread throughout the countryside - sorrow was turned into joy, defeat was turned into victory. England rejoiced and new hope came. The feared invasion never resulted for the enemy was defeated.

Last Friday, we remembered how on a battlefield greater than Waterloo, heaven's mighty warrior engaged the powers of darkness in conflict. Jesus Christ fought the forces of Hell at Calvary, tasting their unbridled fury. When He died, it appeared that Christ had been vanquished. His head fell upon His chest and Jesus Christ gave up His spirit. When He ceased to breathe, a dark pall sank over all of the land.

As Jesus was lain in the tomb on the first Good Friday afternoon, hope had died even in the hearts of Jesus' most loyal friends. After the frightful crucifixion, the fog of




