

Notice is hereby given pursuant to Section 11 (1) of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter M.25, as amended, that the Council of the Town of Milton, at its meeting to be held in Town Hall, 43 Brown Street, on April 25, 2005 beginning at 7:30 pm will consider the passing of by-laws for extending the temporary closure for the reconstruction of Sixth Line from Lower Base Line to Britannia Road, and Lower Base Line from Ninth Line to Trafalgar Road, between May 7, 2005 and July 29, 2005.

Plans detailing this project are available for viewing during normal business hours at the Town of Milton's Engineering Services Department at 555 Industrial Drive.

Council will hear, in person, or by their counsel, any person who claims that their lands will be prejudicially affected by the said by-laws, and who applies to be heard. Persons wishing to be heard should notify the Clerk's Department in writing, no later than 10:00 AM, Monday, April 25, 2005.


