Diplomat Pacing Series continues tonight

Seven horses have been drawn into tonight's \$25,000 second leg of the Diplomat Pacing Series at Woodbine, which will not see opening leg victors Stonebridge Regal and Arties Samartie compete.

With those two Bob McIntosh pupils on the sidelines, the showdown is now wide open. Still, Ijustdontgiveacam will be representing McIntosh, and the colt could easily be one of the chalk picks.

Owned by his trainer along with Al McIntosh and James Machan, Ijustdontgiveacam was unraced as a two-year-old, but has had a knack for hitting the board so far this year.

The bay son of Camluck has compiled a 5-2-1 record and \$65,660 in earnings from his 10 season starts.

Among those set to race tonight, he has the most season wins and biggest 200 bankroll.

Along with Village Joshua, Ijustdontgiveacam is the only one in the field that competed in the final

of the recently-concluded Youthful Pacing Series. After leaving from post position five in the finale, he failed to find the confines of the rail and had to settle for eighth — finishing nearly 10 lengths back of winner Stonebridge Regal.

Prior to the Youthful final, I justdontgiveacam had won a division of the series' opening leg. The colt also won a second leg division of the Apaches Fame Pacing Series last month before finishing six-and-a-half lengths back in second to Putnam Romeo in the \$56,000 final — pacing his mile in

1:54.1.

P H Breakaway hit the board in all eight of his 2004 starts, and from those six victories he's the winningest performer in tonight's field.

After five starts so far this season, the trainee of conditioner Kevin McMaster has had a lone place finish and two shows — good for \$17,850 in earnings.

Lis Mara, who chased Stonebridge Regal to the wire last week, has drawn the outside seven-hole. After putting in a sharp 1:54.1 mile at Flamborough, the Cambest colt finished just three-quarters of a length in arrears last week, pacing in 1:55.3 over an off track. Trainer William McNeil has listed Paul MacKenzie to perform tonight's driving duties.

The series is restricted to non-winners of \$50,000 in 2004 and has a \$92.500 (estimated) final slated next Friday.


