## NOTICE OF PUBLIC OPEN HOUSE

### YOU ARE INVITED To Attend a Public Open House On Halton's Draft Tree Bylaw and Revised Environmental Impact Assessment Guidelines

The Draft Halton Tree Bylaw, intended to replace the current Bylaw adopted by Council in 1983, has been further revised after extensive public consultation in March 2004 and subsequent agency and staff review earlier this year. The Revised Bylaw will be presented at a Public Open House for comment before a final version is prepared for Regional Council's consideration.

Also, the Halton Regional Official Plan Five Year Review identified the need to revise Halton's Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Guidelines. Regional Council approved the existing EIA Guidelines in 1979. The purpose of an EIA is to identify and assess the potential environmental impacts and mitigation measures of a land-use development proposal. A draft of the guidelines is now available for public review and a Public Open House to consider both the Tree Bylaw and the EIA Guidelines is scheduled for:

## NOTICE OF ROAD ALLOWANCE CLOSURE

### Trafalgar Road (Regional Road 3) at Lower Base Line, Town of Milton

The Regional Municipality of Halton is recommending the approval of a by-law for the permanent closure of a road allowance adjacent to Trafalgar Road (Regional Road 3) in the Town of Milton. Regional staff are recommending that the property in question be declared surplus, thereby requiring deletion from the Regional Road system.

The property is located on the southwest quadrant of the intersection of Trafalgar Road (Regional Road 3) and Lower Base Line, more specifically referred to as follows:

Part of Trafalgar Road (Regional Road 3),  
 being part of Lot 12, Concession 2, north of Dundas Street. (Trafalgar)  
 Town of Oakville, Regional Municipality of Halton  
 Part of PIN 24930-0098 (LT)

Pursuant to S. 34(1) of the Municipal Act and Halton Region Notice Provisions Policy, public notice must be given for a minimum of 2 consecutive weeks, not less than 14 days prior to the consideration of the by-law. Regional Council proposes at its Planning and Public Works Committee meeting on May 25, 2005 (9:30 am) and Council meeting on June 1, 2005 (9:30 am) to pass a by-law for the permanent closure of this road allowance adjacent to Trafalgar Road (Regional Road 3) in the Town of Milton.
