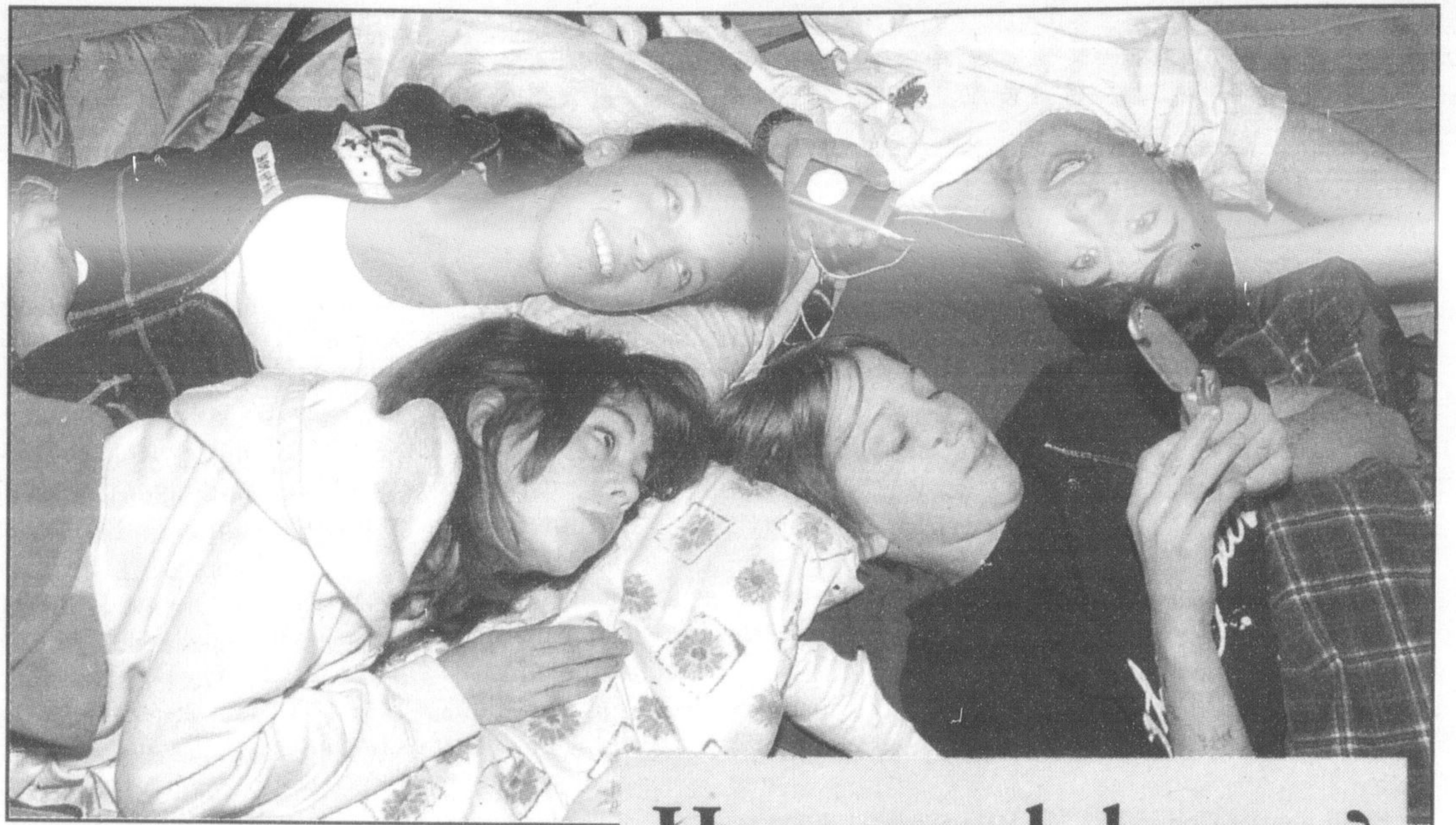
Notice of Surplus Land
