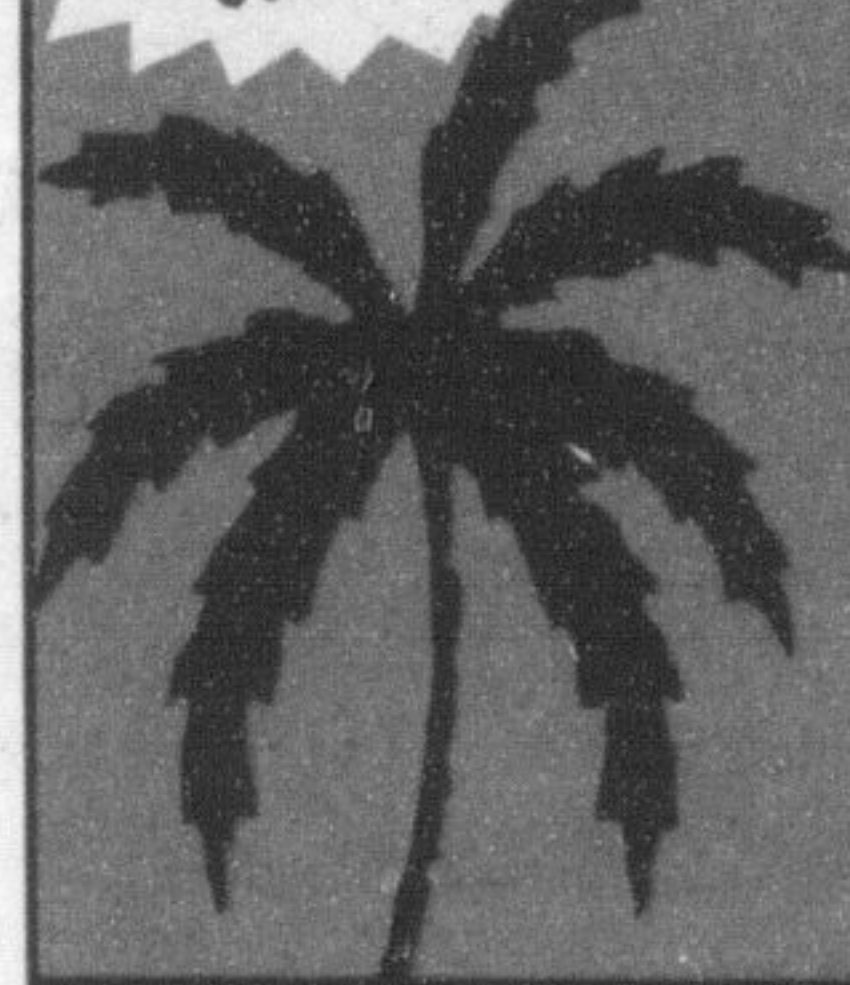

NEW BURLOAK WATER PURIFICATION PLANT IN THE TOWN OF OAKVILLE

The Region of Halton is currently in the preliminary design phase of the new Burloak Water Purification Plant, which will be located on the south side of Rebecca Street just east of Great Lakes Boulevard in the Town of Oakville. The preliminary design phase began upon completion of the Environmental Study Report in November 2004. To achieve the goal of designing a facility that is compatible with the surrounding community, the Region has established a Citizen Advisory Committee to provide input on the architectural and landscaping design of the Burloak Water Purification Plant and to provide comment to the project team with respect to the construction activities for the project.

Halton Region is hosting a Public Information Centre to provide you with information about the preliminary design and construction schedule. Representatives from Halton Region, the plant design consultant MacViro Consultants Inc., the noise consultant Aercoustics and members of the Burloak Water Purification Plant Citizen Advisory Committee, will be in attendance to answer any questions.
