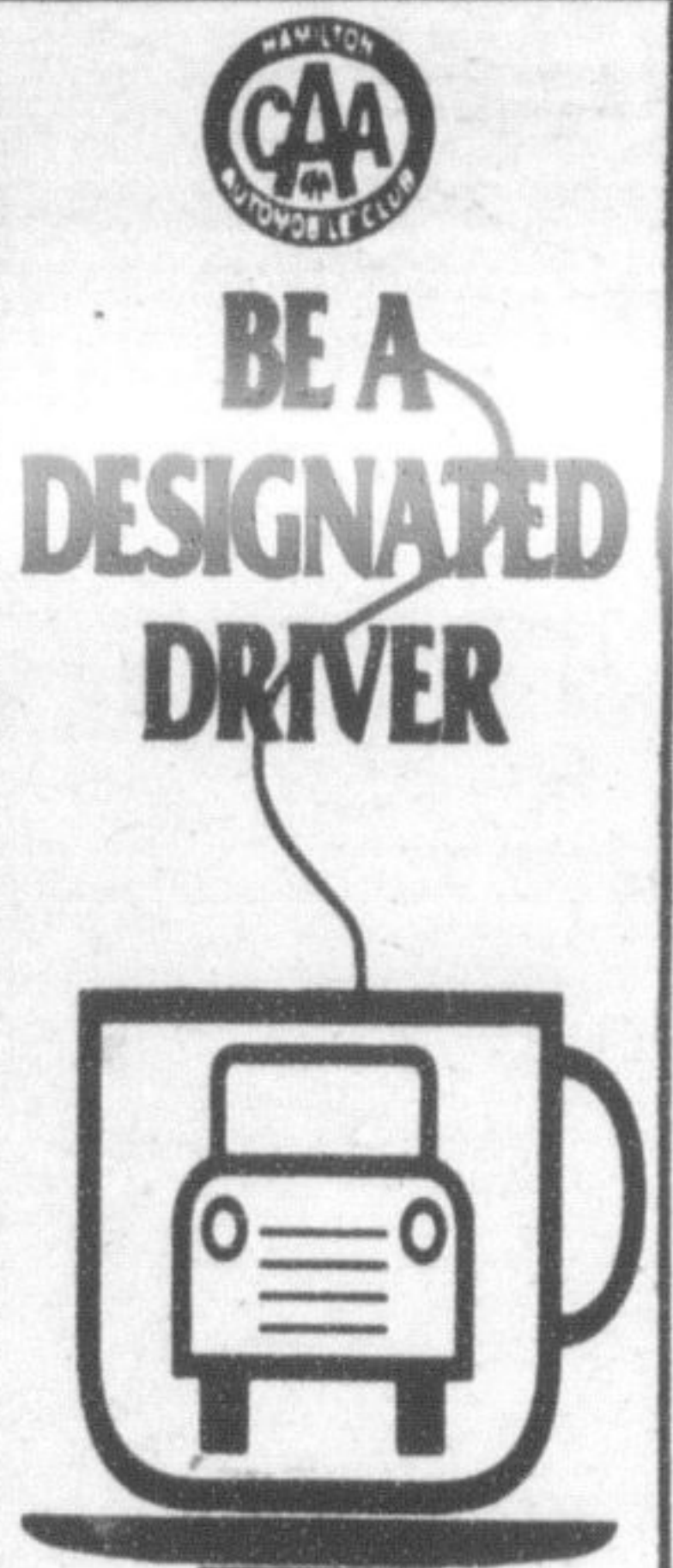


Pizza party

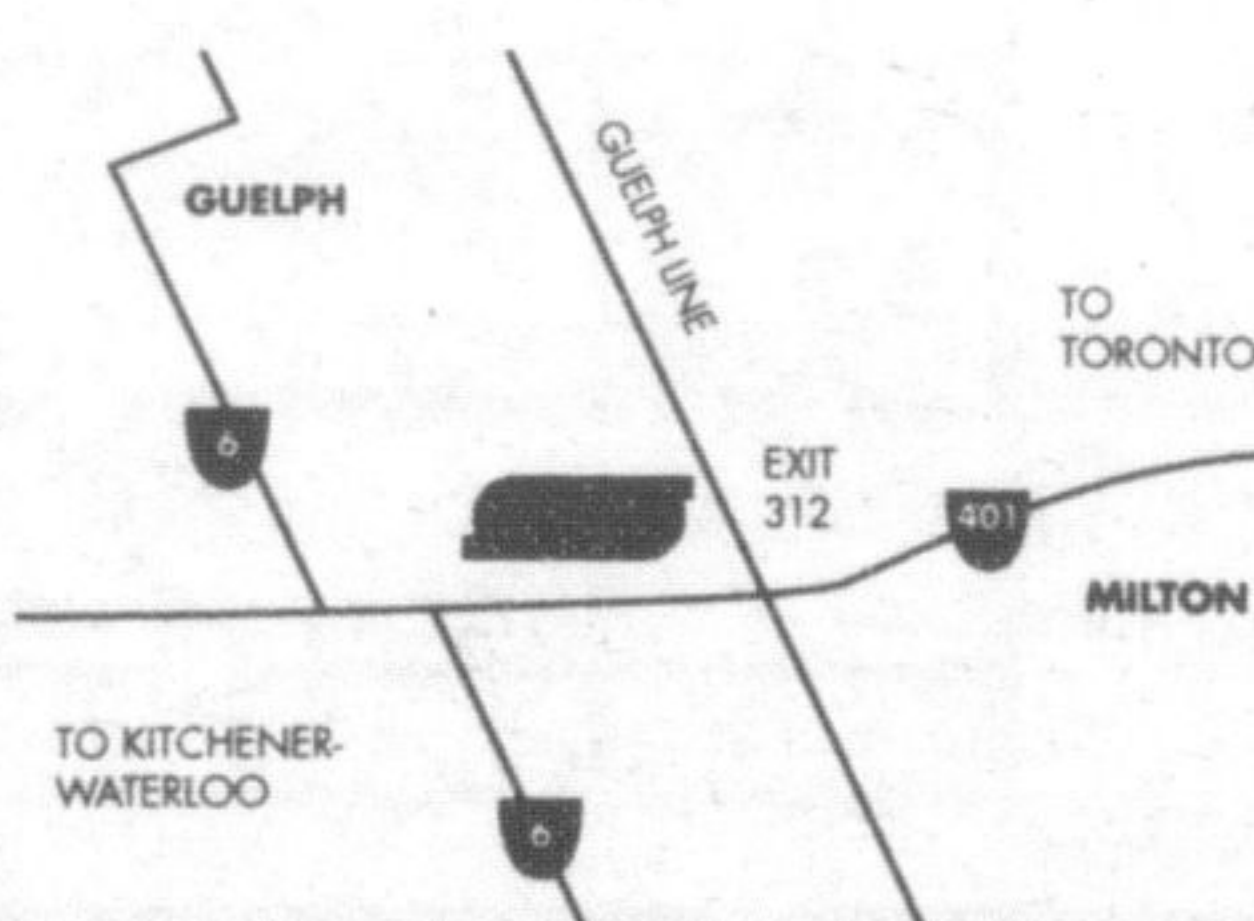
