



Maplehurst inmate found dead in cell

A Maplehurst inmate charged in the murder of a fellow Acton man was found in his cell without vital signs Wednesday after-

Less than an hour later, 44-year-old Rene Paulin was pronounced dead. Halton Regional Police refused to comment on the cause of death, but said foul play isn't suspected.

Mr. Paulin was charged with second-degree murder in the April stabbing of Hanzel Honeywell, 45, in Acton.

Ministry of Corrections spokesperson Julia Noonan said Mr. Paulin was found in his cell just after 3 p.m. by prison officials who attempted to resuscitate him. He was taken to Milton District Hospital where he was pronounced dead.

The Ministry of Corrections is conducting its own investigation in addition to the police's, she said, and a mandatory inquest will be held.

Ms Noonan said he was the only inmate in the cell. She couldn't comment on how he died.

"I don't want to damage the integrity of the inquest or any of the investigations taking place," she said.
