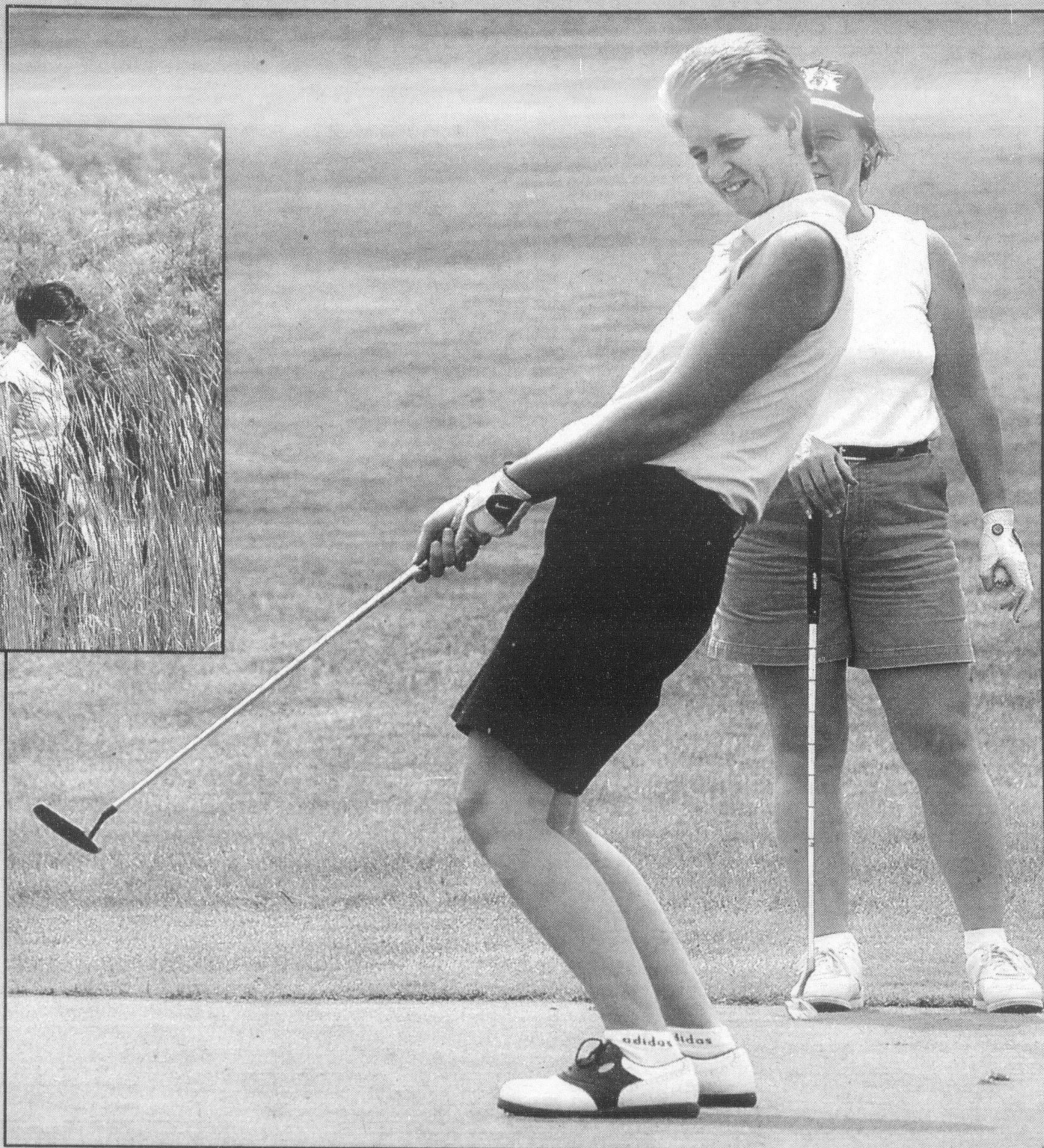


In the swing of things

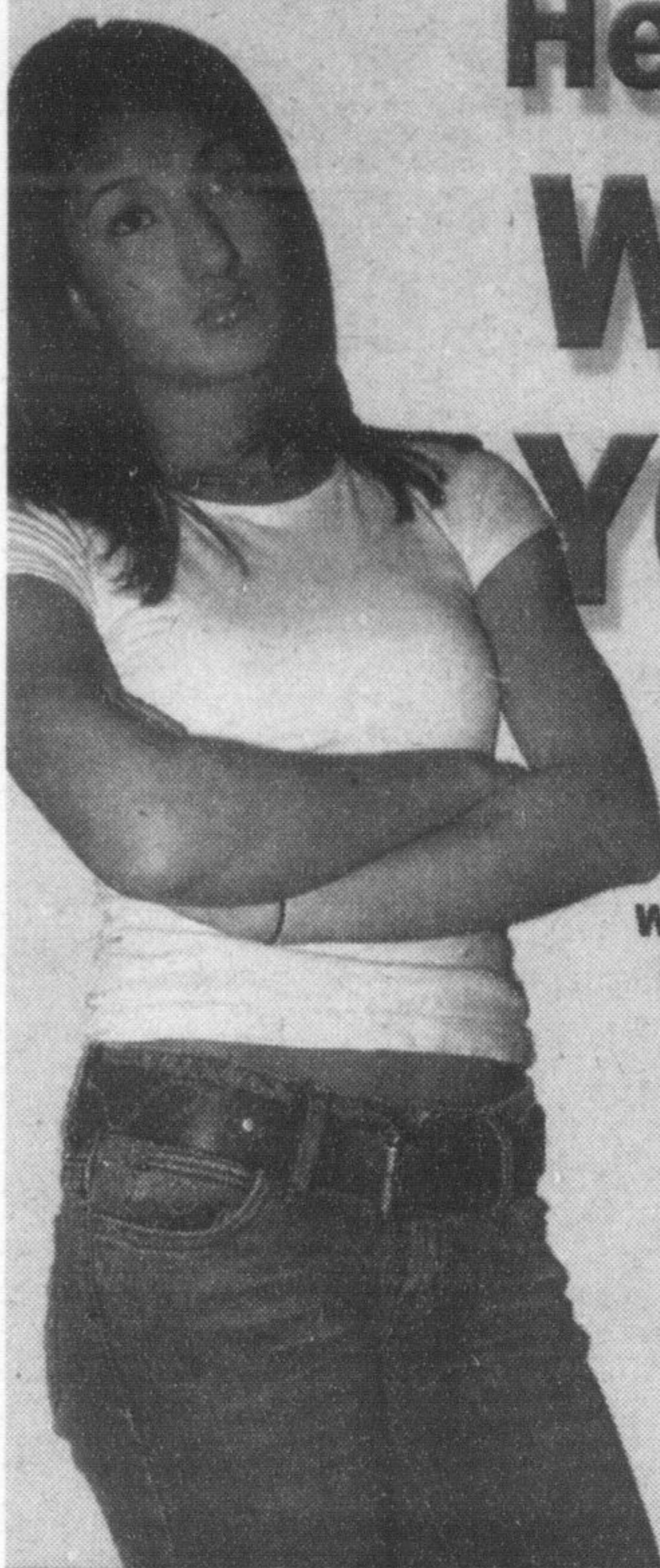
