Weight-loss program busts dieting myths, says creator

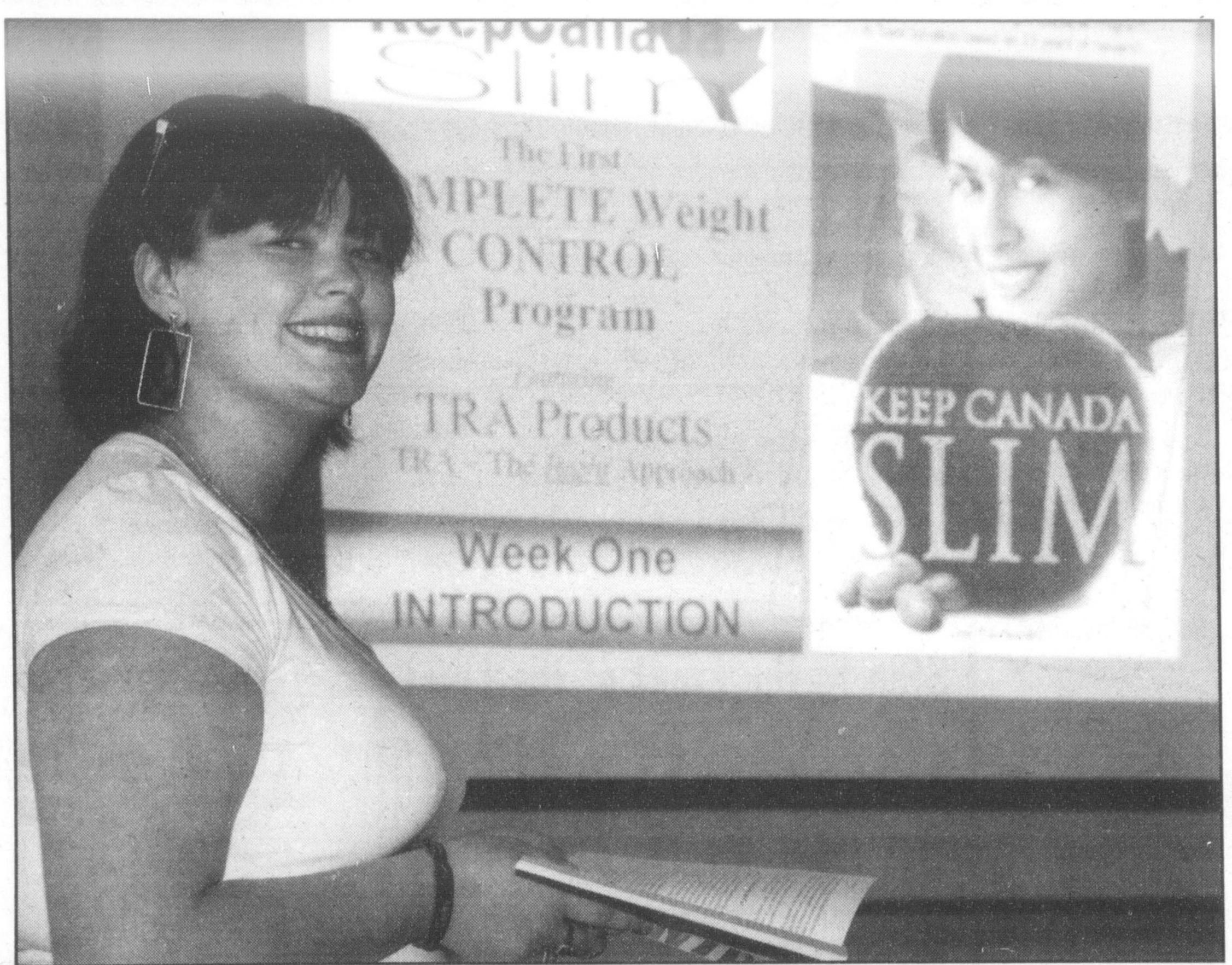

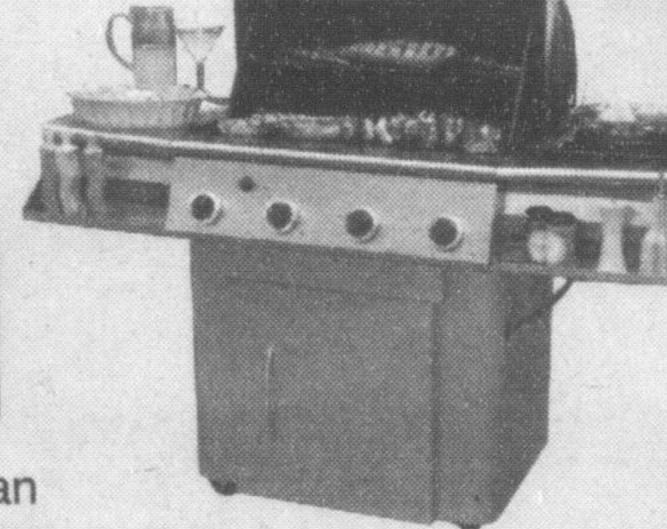

Keep Canada Slim (KCS), a program based on a book developed by former local resident Lee Fairbanks, conducted its Milton launch of a five-week weight control program at the Milton Leisure Centre Wednesday.

KCS certified consultant Pam Coad was on hand to introduce the program, which has already launched in Mississauga and been in the United States for a number of years under the name Keep America Slim.

The program seeks to bust dieting myths and flout conventions in an effort to get obesity under control.

For instance, Mr. Fairbanks wrote, sometimes eating too little can be a roadblock in attaining a healthy body.

"Eating less than your minimum metabolic needs causes your body to burn muscle and store fat," Mr. Fairbanks explained at a prior speaking engagement.

Ms Coad explained the 'Starvation Metabolism' response, where the body, when deprived of adequate calories, will adapt to need fewer calories to function. As a result, dieters often regain the weight they lose almost immediately because they have starved their body into becoming a "fat-storing machine."

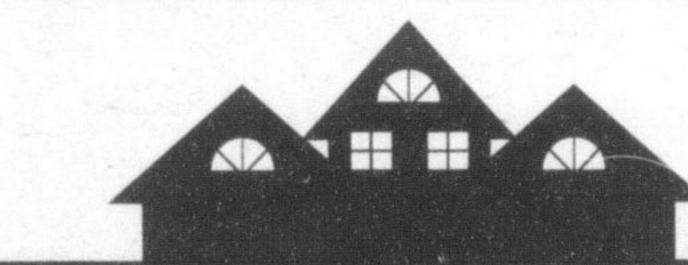
And maybe more surprising than the need to eat to lose weight, said Ms Coad, is the role of exercise in slimming down.

"You don't necessarily need to exercise to lose weight," said Ms Coad. In fact, the program calls for no exercise until Week 4. Instead, vitamins are a large part of the KCS formula, she said, and they work to help the body eliminate fat instead of store

The program uses Pharmanex nutritional

supplements, which are one of the only supplements US Olympic athletes are allowed to take.

But like any weight-loss program, said Ms Coad, KCS has rules—but just two. First, people on the program should get less than 20 per cent of their calories from fat, and second, they should eat smaller quantities of food, but eat more often.

Other popular diet programs like the Zone and Slim-Fast were explored, and she explained that the reason many of these programs fail is because they're each missing something.

KCS also dismisses scales as misleading when trying to measure fat loss, and instead uses tape measures to record inches lost, not pounds.

When trying to win the battle of the bulge, another tool Mr. Fairbanks advocates in his book is healthy stress management.

"Stress is the newest ingredient to obesity," said Ms Coad. "Not a lot of programs address it."

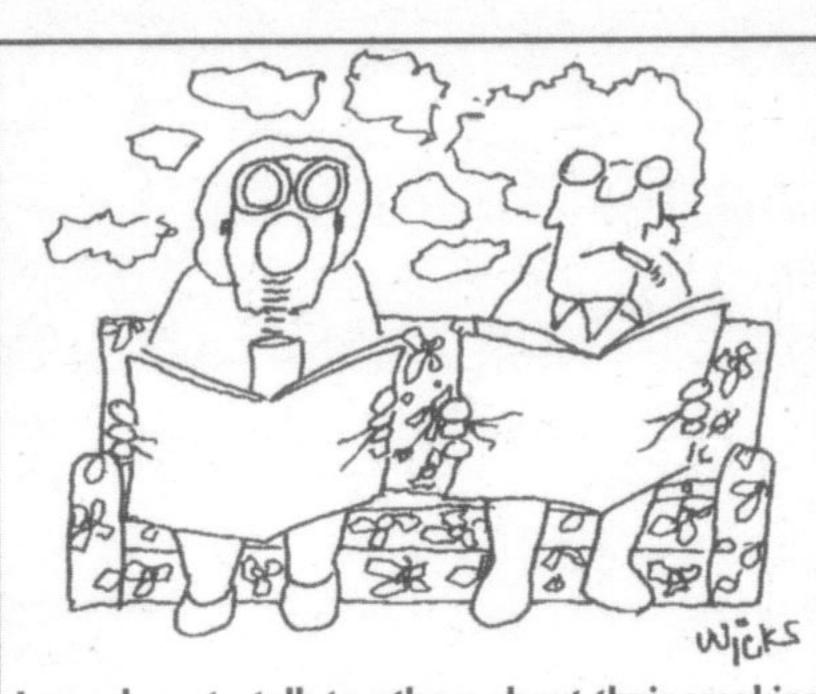
Ms Coad said the program allows participants to maintain their desired weight for a lifetime, offers weekly coaching, encourages better sleeping patterns and leaves dieters with more energy.

The program costs \$350 for the first month, and additional months cost \$130. For the fee, participants get a weight control package that includes Mr. Fairbanks' book, Pharmanex nutritional supplements, a carb counter and meal supplements.

Mr. Fairbanks began developing the KCS program in 1995 after witnessing diet-related health issues in his own family. He has lectured and written on health-related issues since 1992, and calls KCS the "first complete weight loss program."

Keep Canada Slim will be in Canadian bookstores the first week of August.
