
The eventual OMB hearing will decide if the Regional plan will stand or be adjusted based on the appeals launched by numerous major developers — including north Oakville landowners representatives of the aggregate industry, Upper Canada College and the Woodbine Entertainment Group.

Halton Region's adoption of ROPA 25 ended a four-year review process to ensure the revised plan addresses growth, affordable housing, environmental protection, agriculture and transportation. It's a new planning vision that sets a firm urban boundary for growth to 2021, deals with Guidelines and a new tree bylaw.

affordable housing, supports Halton's farming community, enhances the greenlands system, commits to air and water quality improvements, and promotes alternate transportation, like public transit, cycling, and walking.

It involved an extensive public consultation program consisting of six open houses, workshops and focus group meetings, a mailing list of more than 900 people and nearly a dozen technical reports.

Key among those reports were a Ninth Line Corridor Land Use Study, Livestock Operation
