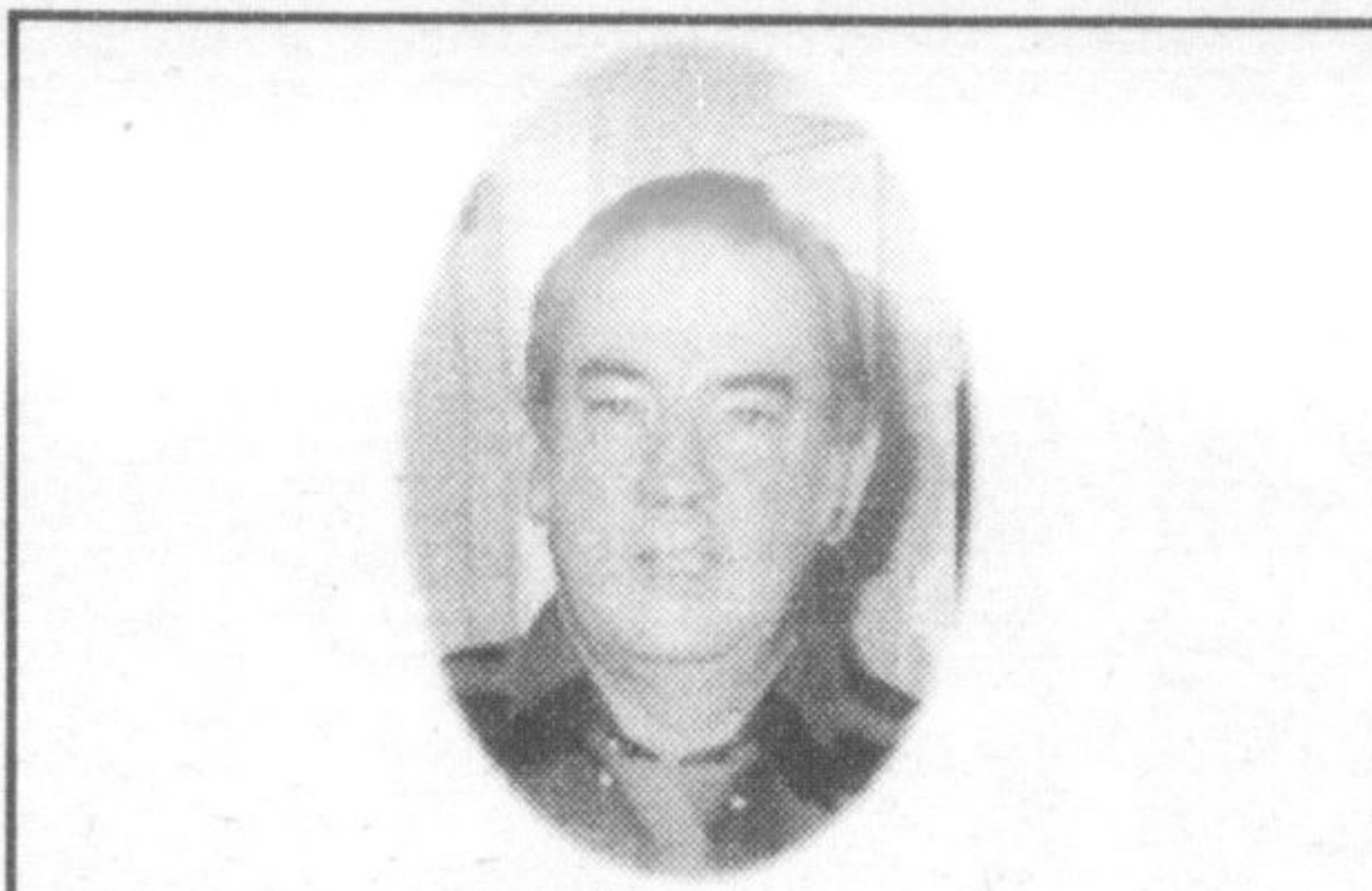

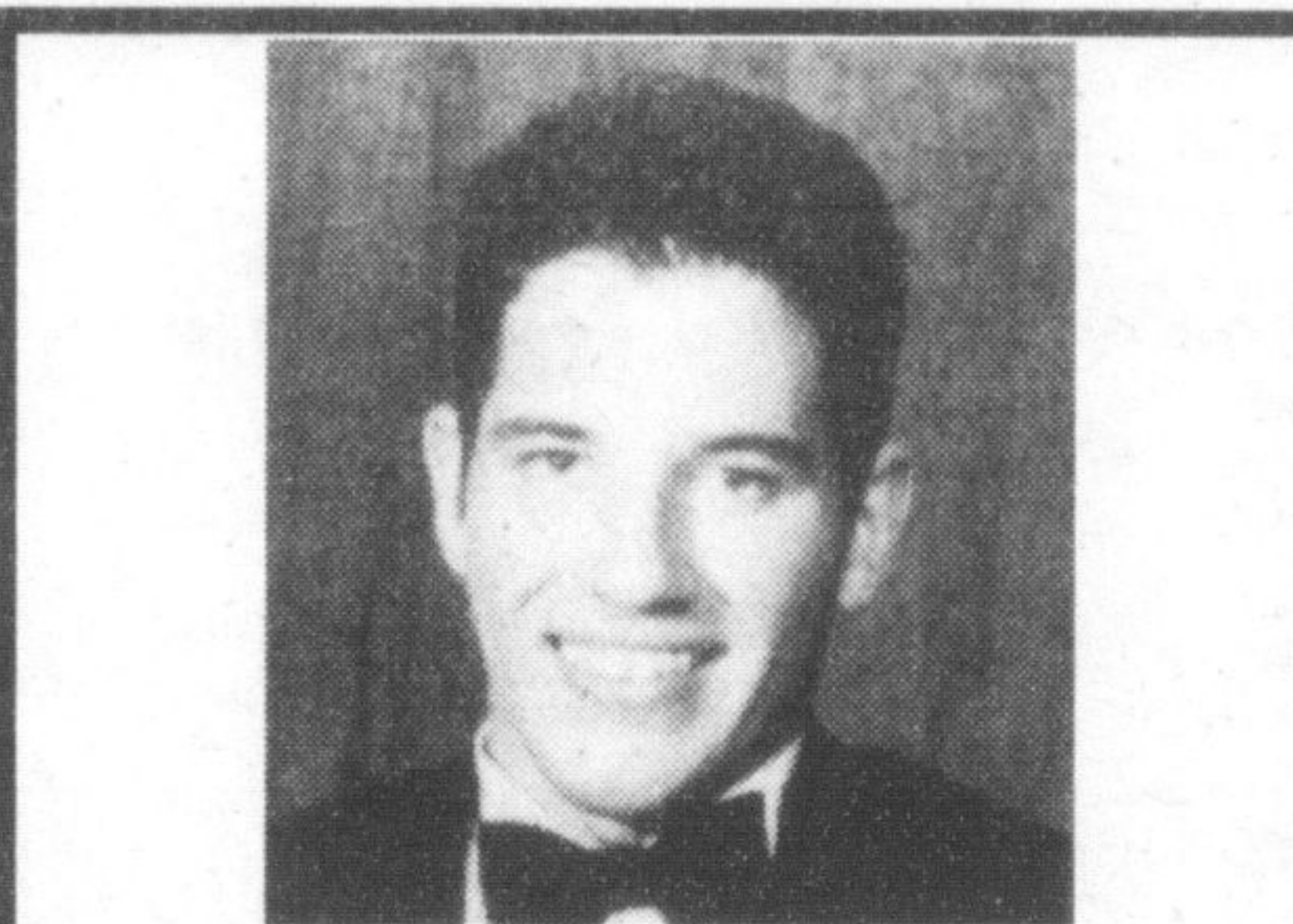


**Bryant, Kenneth William**

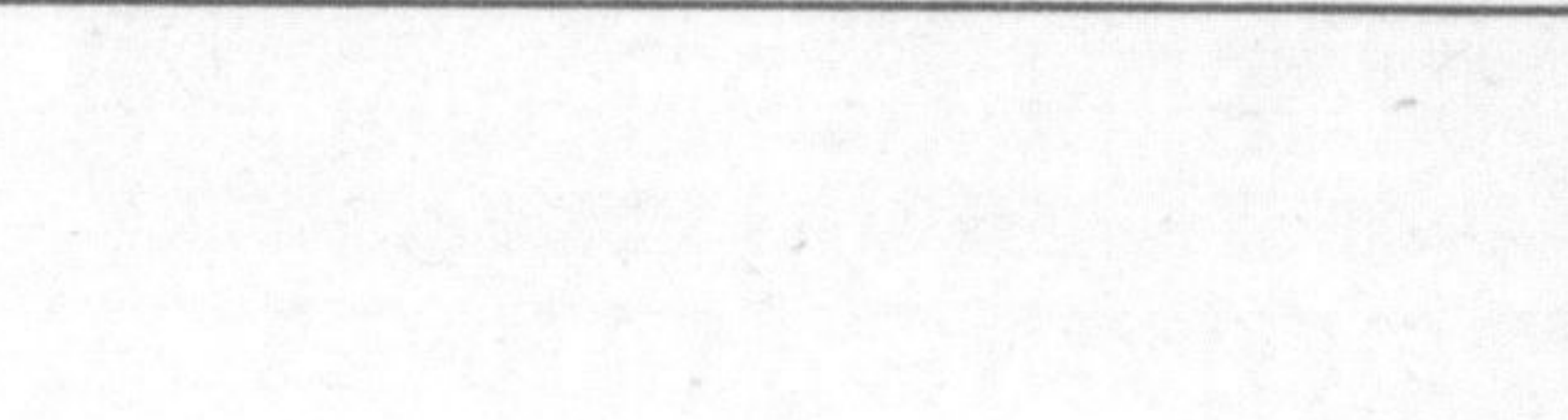
