When you thought I wasn't looking, I saw you take care of our house and everyone in it and I learned we have to take care of what we are given.

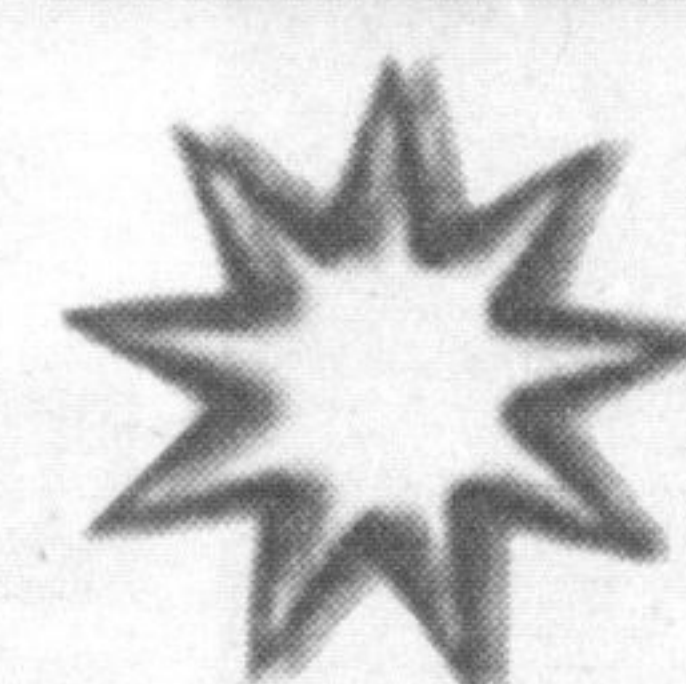
