This year marks the 45th year for Steam-Era at the Milton fairgrounds. The show will be on throughout Labour Day weekend starting Friday September 2nd until Monday September 5th at 5pm. This years show will feature a new theme for 2005 presenting the "POWER OF STEAM" which will show case a vast assortment of steam powered equipment. The aim is to provide a fun and educational experience for young and old. Great efforts have been made to provide a good cross section of steam power from small models to several different gages of model live steam locomotives, which will be in operation on specially set up tracks. Rides will be available. There will be many different scale model traction engines not to mention the usual complement of full size steam engines in daily operation.

Special displays of static nature will also provide a learning hands on opportunity with attendance willing to answer any and all questions. There will also be short steam engine related seminars at the special display tent several times a day for the enquiring individual.

Each day activities will be on going throughout the grounds. Stroll through the gas engine area and see hundreds of small and large hit and miss engines. Continue your adventure throughout the crafts building with all sorts of knitted, sewn and quilted items. See arts and crafts, buy some baked goods and you can continue your stroll to the flea market area or models building. Hundreds of hours have been spent by talented machinist making intricate scale working models for you to see. From there you can go to the toy and train building, do some shopping or stop in the food court area for some.

Check the events schedule for grand stand activities at the "Browns Fuel" main stage. There will be tractor and steam engine skills demonstrations at various times. The threshing competition takes place Saturday Sunday and Monday at 3pm pitting rival threshing crews against the clock to stook, load, and belt up. Then thrash a load of grain using steam engines and big turn of the century gas tractors just like you would have seen in the early 1900's.

The antique cars will be on display in field along with every size, color and make of vintage tractor you care to mention. See them all in the "Grand Parade" each day from the grand stands at 4pm. After the parade have some



supper, take in the corn roast and stay for the evening entertainment. Friday night at 7:30 the "Pierce Family Band" will play country western music on stage. Saturday night will be the 28th Annual Country Western Talent contest and Sunday at 5:30pm watch for the mini tractor pulls followed at 8pm by "Settlers Creek" live on the Browns Fuels sponsored stage playing popular country western music. Don't forget the best steamed corn you will find anywhere, guaranteed!

Adult admission is \$6.00 on Friday and \$7.00 Saturday, Sunday and Monday. Children under 12 with an adult are free. An adult weekend pass can be purchased for \$15.00 if you wish to come more then one day or evening. Entrances are at Thomas St. and at Robert St. Visit www.steam-era.com online for more information. 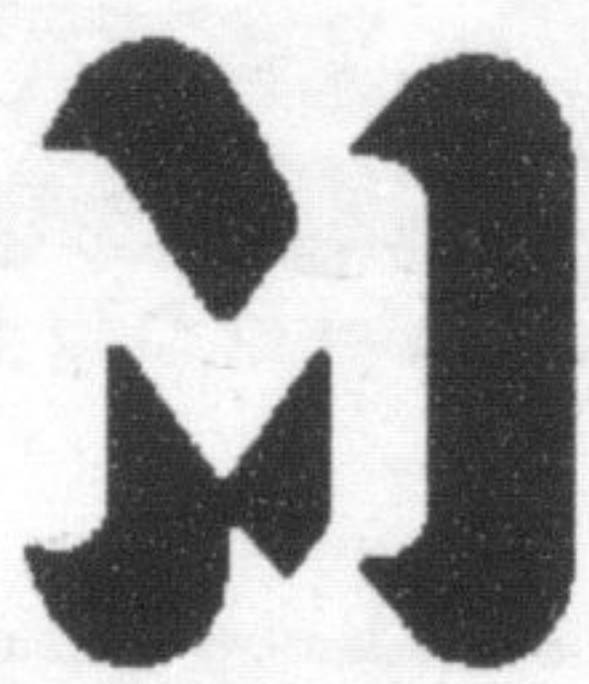
