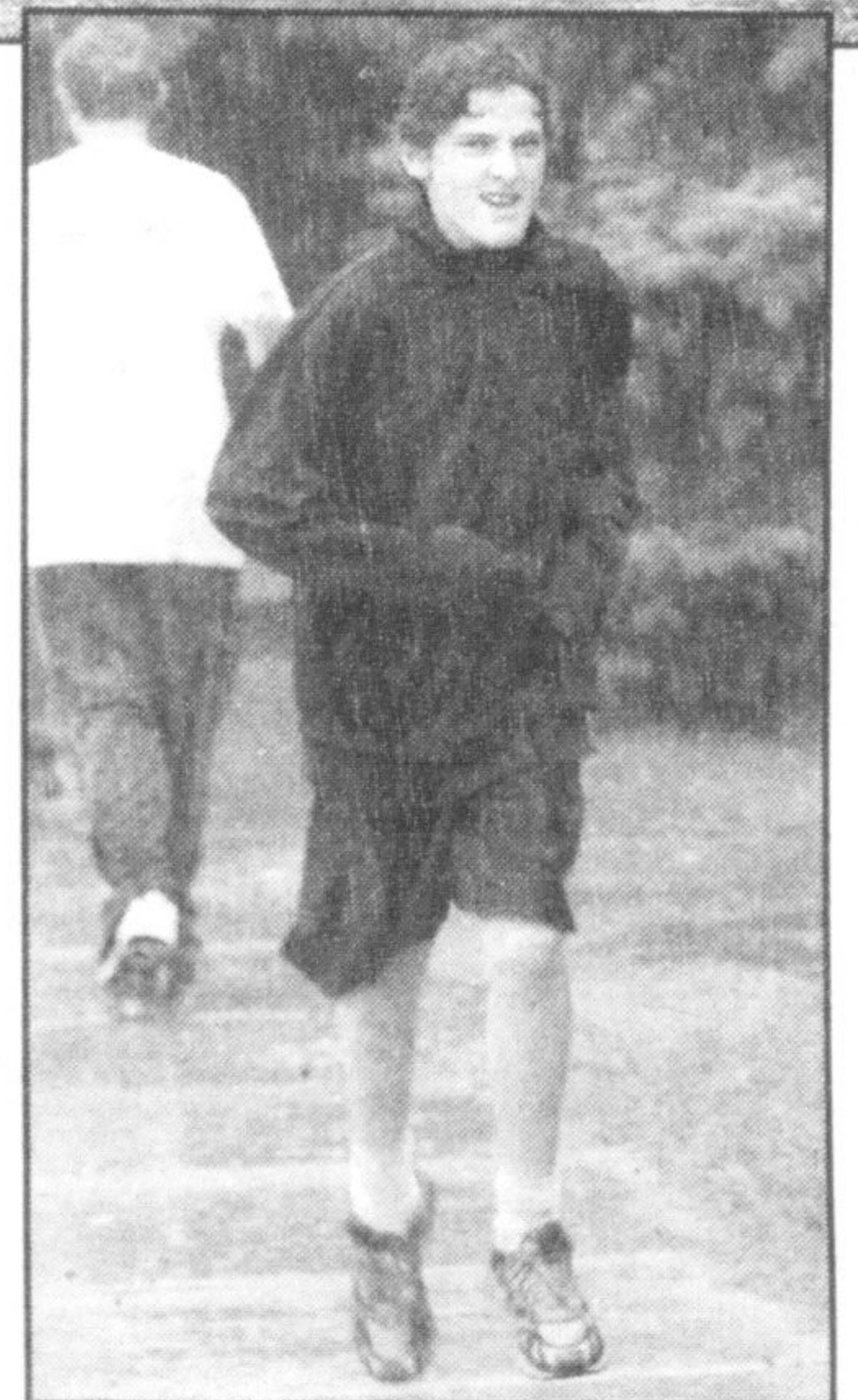




Shaved and soaked in Terry's honour

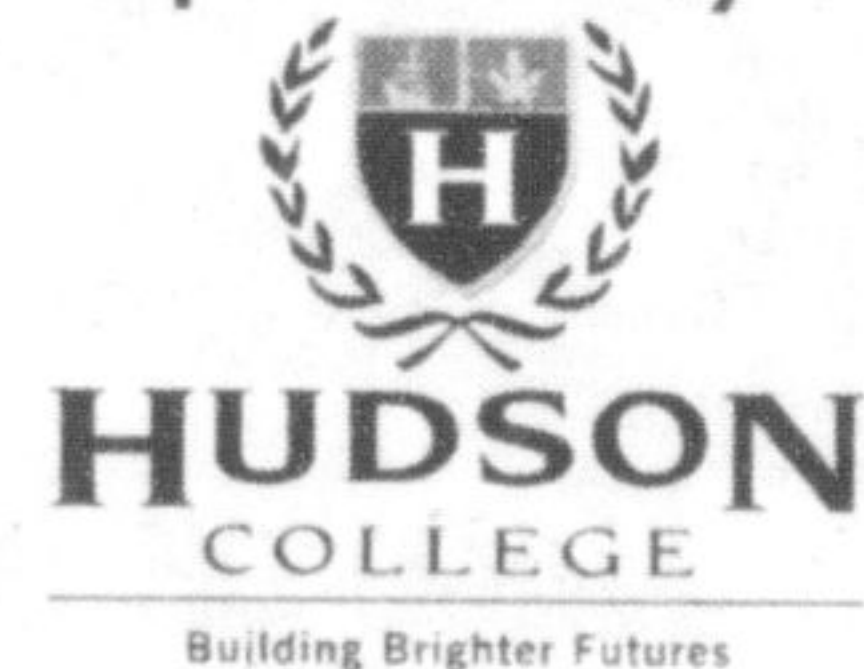

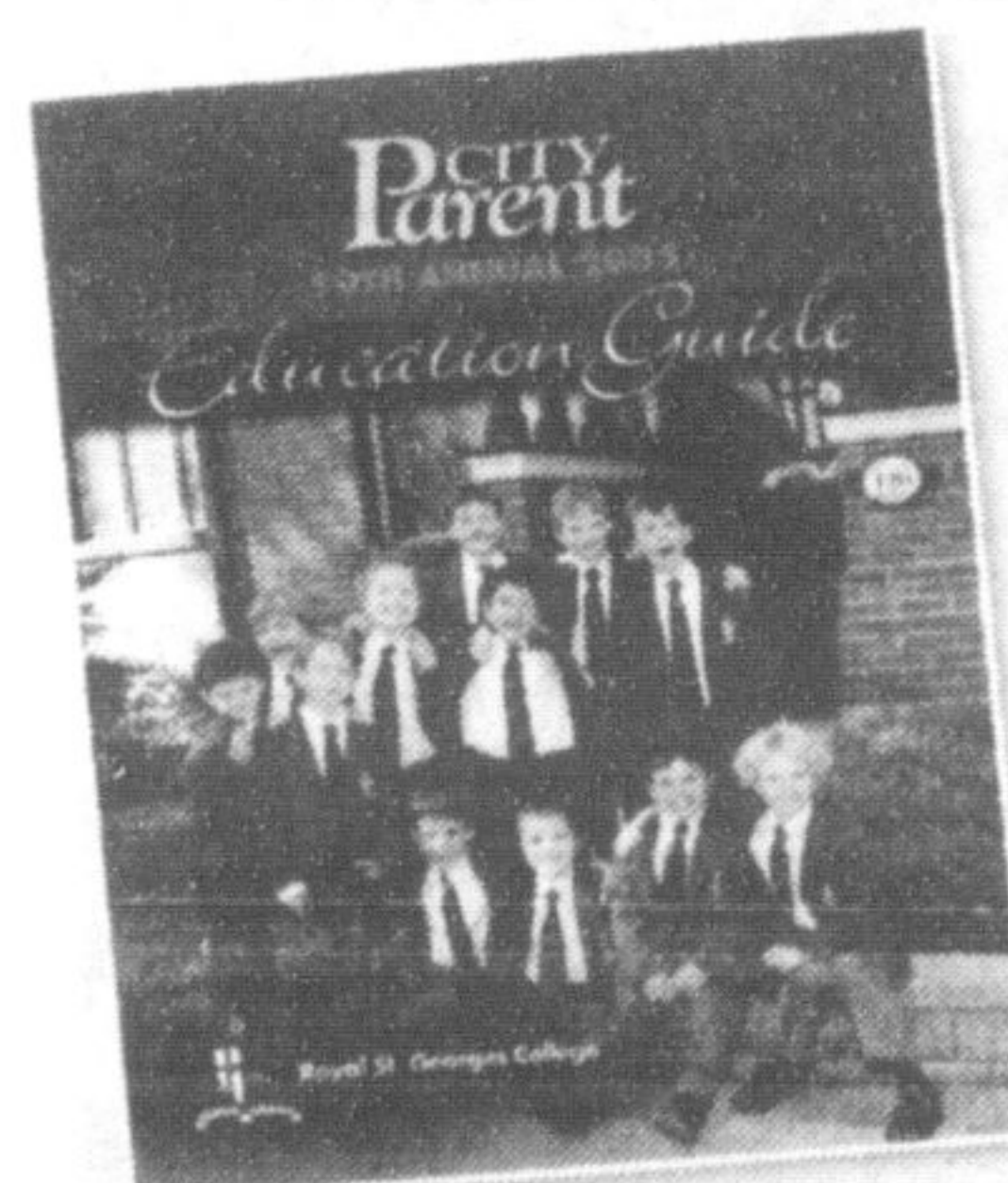
