Lace up those walking shoes and take a step toward ending abuse against women this weekend at the second annual Riverside Walk.

The event that'll be held in Oakville Sunday will raise funds and awareness for Halton Women's Place, which provides shelter services for women and their dependent children in the region. It's being organized by Ramsden Training and Halton Women's Place.

"We chose to support Halton Women's Place to help the brave women of our community who have made the very difficult decision to stop the cycle of violence by accessing this organization," said Peter Ramsden, owner of Ramsden Training.

"The best thing that can happen to this event is that it will one day become redundant. In the meantime, we will do what we can to help the shelter and make people aware of the need for Halton Women's Place."

The five kilometre walk will take place at Lions Valley Park along the Sixteen Mile Creek. Registration starts at 9 a.m. and the walk begins at 10 a.m.

Complimentary snacks will be provided after the walk at the Niblick Pub at 1011 Upper Middle Rd. All participants will also receive a free t-shirt.

The mission of Halton Women's Place is to end violence against women and children, in turn creating healthier relationships and healthier communities in the region.

Last year, more than 700 women and 400 children accessed Halton Women's Place's services as residential and/or community clients. Staff also responded to 1,883 crisis calls.
