

Gord Krantz's 25 years of hard work and dedication to his position as Milton's mayor was recognized Saturday evening at a celebration hosted by the local Chamber of Commerce.

The event, held at Rattlesnake Point Golf Club, brought together about 400 of Mr. Krantz's family members, friends and colleagues, along with Milton business people and residents all looking to pay tribute to the mayor's many years of public service.

Mr. Krantz and his wife, Olive, entered the affair in grand style with a bagpiper and procession of local firefighters who the mayor used to serve with
