

Grant to support outdoor education programs

Conservation Halton has launched a new program aimed at the region's students, thanks to a grant from the Ontario Trillium Foundation.

The \$277,500 allowance will support the Green Futures community outreach program, which is aimed at engaging Halton's students and families in innovative education and outdoor learning experiences.

"Through Green Futures, Conservation Halton (CH) will bring the message and practice of conservation to its watershed citizens in a manner that shows our commitment to working with the Halton com-

munity to sustain a healthy watershed," said Milton councillor and CH chair Brian Penman.

Green Futures will include several major annual community events starting next year, such as the launch of the Halton Children's Water Festival, which will be held in partnership with Halton Region.

CH will also launch the Science Mentors and Innovators Program in which local grade 12 students will participate in a mentored science competition with local graduate students and industry experts.

Other initiatives include the storm-drain

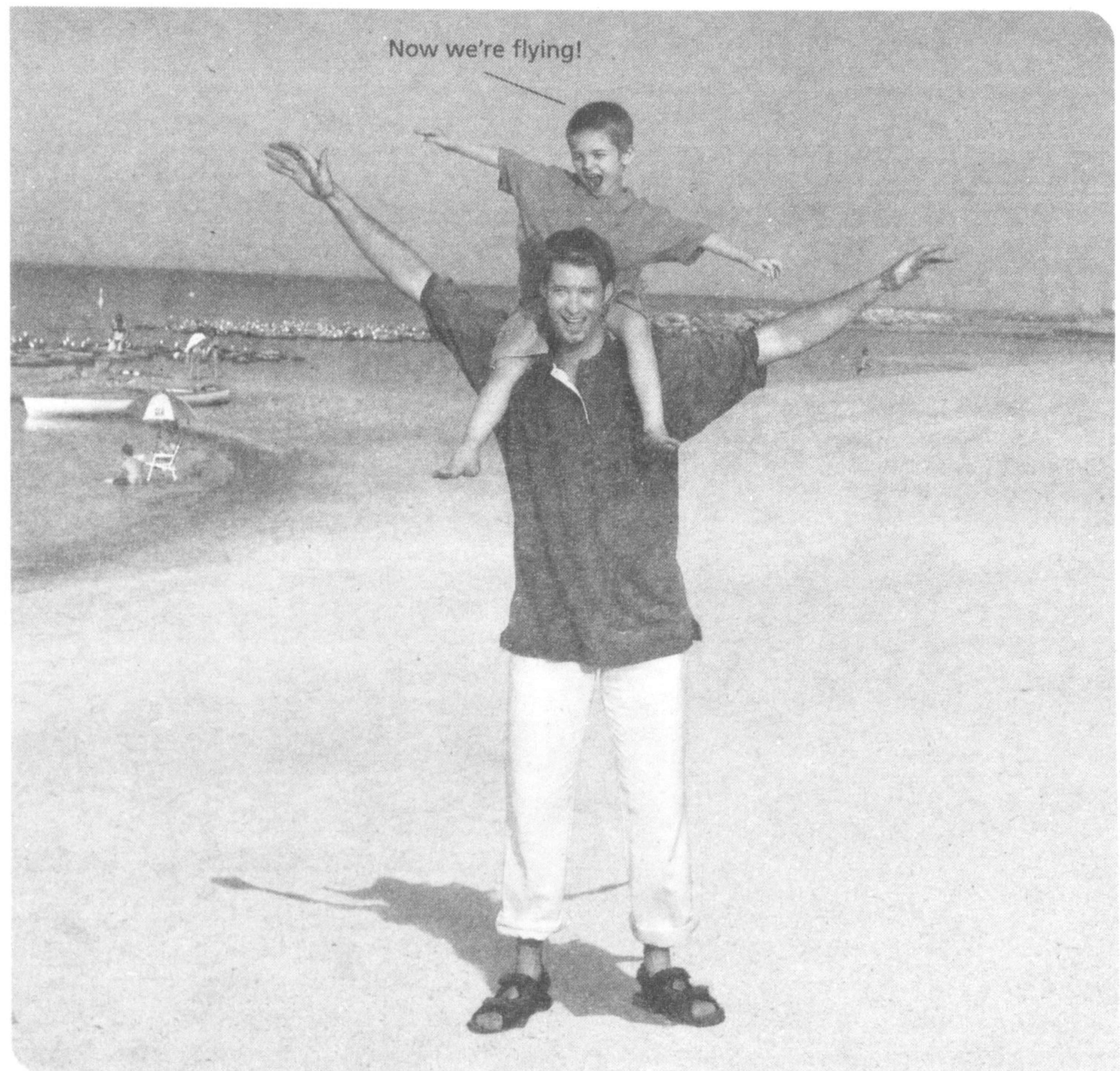
marking Yellow Fish Road program and the innovative Stream of Dreams program, which blends art and natural history to create murals using hand-painted wooden

fish.

Green Futures also includes a community-based tree planting initiative called Trees for Watershed Health.
