munity to sustain a healthy watershed," said Milton councillor and CH chair Brian Penman.


Green Futures will include several major annual community events starting next year, such as the launch of the Halton Children's Water Festival, which will be held in partnership with Halton Region.

CH will also launch the Science Mentors and Innovators Program in which local grade 12 students will participate in a men-. tored science competition with local graduate students and industry experts.


Other initiatives include the storm-drain
