gle detached, semi-detached and townhouses, a village square, two parks, two woodlots and greenlands.

Main Street Milton Corp. is seeking a zoning bylaw amendment as well to change the 102-acre property from a future development zone to residential medium density, open space and greenlands.

Both developers are also seeking approval of their proposed subdivision plans.

No decisions on the potential developments will be made at the public meetings. That will happen after staff has fully

reviewed the applications and brings forward recommendations to council.

Copies of the initial staff reports on both proposed subdivisions will be available by Thursday afternoon through the Planning and Development Department at Town Hall Annex 555, located at 555 Industrial Dr.
