 liative care and ensuring a pain free, peaceful death.

Anne Deoni also wanted more focus to be placed on research into cures for debilitating diseases such as multiple sclerosis and Lou Gehrig's.

"A lot of illnesses previously considered doomed aren't... look at the cancer that killed Terry Fox. Now, 25 years later, it is curable because of research," said Ms

Deoni.

The right to die with dignity bill was introduced to the legislature by Bloc MP Francine Lalonde. It received first reading in June and will be debated during second reading in the House of Commons likely at the end of the month. MPs will then vote on whether to send it to a parliamentary committee for review or to trash it.

Normally private member's bills don't travel far, but with a minority

government they have more potential to become law.

Mr. Carr assured Saturday's participants that their comments would guide his vote in the legislature.

"I will make my decision based on today's consultation and others received, not according to a party whip," said Mr. Carr, adding he has voted against the grain of the Liberal party line six times in the past year.
