"We think the best kind of health care is health care you find close to home," he noted.

Another benefit of FHTs is access to comprehensive healthcare 24 hours a day, seven days a week. After hours a registered nurse will be available through the Telephone Health Advisory Service.

The team is currently located in a medical building on Main Street East, but that's only a temporary location until the official opening of

Building next June.

The team has big plans over the coming months, which include recruiting more doctors and other health professionals.

"The nurse practitioner and mental health worker are the first of several additional health care professionals the Prime Care Family Health Team plans to add so that we can serve more patients," said Dr. Maley.

The local team is part of the first wave of FHTs

its new offices in the Bronte Professional announced earlier this year. By 2007-08, 150 teams throughout Ontario will have been created, which will bring better health care to 2.5 million Ontarians.

> "Family Health Teams are the next evolution in primary health care services and are changing the way health care is being delivered in Milton and right across the province," said Mr. Smitherman. "They mean a stronger health care system now and for generations to come."

FHTs come as part of the McGuinty govern-

ment's comprehensive plan to improve health care in Ontario.


