

A 27-hole golf course proposed for rural Milton was given the preliminary thumbs up Wednesday and will go to regional council for consideration tomorrow.

At its meeting last week, Halton's planning and public works committee supported adopting a Regional Official Plan amendment to make way for the course at the southeast corner of Trafalgar and Britannia roads.

While the amendment would apply to a 200-acre piece of land, an additional 100 acres that has been zoned for a golf course for more than 20 years will be added to the development to create the 27-hole facility.

Official plan and zoning bylaw amendments for the potential course also need to be approved by Milton council. A staff recommendation on this is expected to come forward shortly.

Town Manager of Development Review Anne Dawkins told the committee that at this point, it looks like the recommendation from Town staff will be a positive one.

The golf course proposal went before the planning and public works committee late last month, but it was referred back to staff for more information on a few things, like whether approving a trucked-in water supply for the course's clubhouse would create a precedent.

Burlington Councillor John Taylor again raised the question at Wednesday's meeting, but staff told him no precedent would be set since each Official Plan amendment is dealt with on its own merits.

Surface water will be used for irrigation around the course.

An application on the large course was initially made in 2001, but it was put on hold due to the Region's golf course study and the Province's greenbelt plan.

4 injured in serious car crash

Police are looking for witnesses after two cars collided Sunday, sending four people to hospital — one with life-threatening injuries.

The incident happened just before 6 p.m. at the intersection of No. 20 Sideroad and Guelph Line.

Halton Regional Police said a Mazda 626 being driven by a 73-year-old was heading eastbound on No. 20 Sideroad when it failed to stop for a stop sign. The Mazda then collided with a Chrysler Neon travelling south on Guelph Line.

There were two people in each car. All four occupants had to be extricated by emergency personnel, police said.

The driver of the Mazda was sent to Hamilton General Hospital with lifethreatening injuries. The passenger of the Neon was also taken to Hamilton General Hospital, with serious, non-life threatening injuries.

The driver of the Neon suffered serious injuries and was taken to Milton District Hospital. The passenger from the Mazda was treated at Milton District Hospital and released.

Updates on the victims' conditions and hometowns were unavailable at press time yesterday afternoon.
