Region hosts health symposium

The Halton Region Health Department will host its second workplace health symposium Thursday.

Entitled 'Standing Still is not an Option', the event is designed for workplace decision makers, human resource professionals and occupational health practitioners.

"Building Halton's economy involves more than machines, buildings and products," said Halton Regional Chairman Joyce Savoline.

"Employees are the heart of every business, and workplace health is an important part of this equation. The investment employ-

ers make in workplace health programs not only benefits their organization, but is an investment in their employees and the community."


The keynote presentation will feature Dr. Linda Duxbury from Carleton University's Sprott School of Business.
