Of the many birds that fly over desert areas, two live in stark contrast with each other – tiny hummingbirds and great vultures.

The great vultures, with outstretched wings, make their silent sweeping soar, until they spot the rotting carcass of some dead animal and torpedo down upon it. As they scan the rugged terrain of the vast desert, the fallen carcass is all they see.

The tiny hummingbirds, on the other hand, fly over the same rugged terrain without ever noticing the putrid carcass. They hover near cacti and spy the tiny pink blossoms erupting from a cactus' thorns. They flit in and spear a flower with their long bill, drawing sweet nectar from the desert bloom.

The vultures see only the carcasses while the hummingbirds see only the blossoms. Both creatures are able to find what they are looking for.

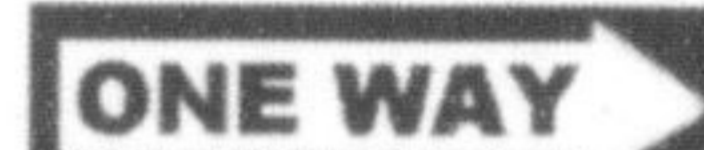
