Youth symphony to stage concert

Nothing seems to ring in the Christmas season better than festive music.

And nobody knows this better than the Halton Youth Symphony, which will present a concert of classics and seasonal music Sunday at 4 p.m. at Nelson High School in Burlington. 'Classics for Christmas' will feature performances by ensembles of the orchestra, the Halton Youth Symphony Orchestra, the Halton Youth Chamber Orchestra and choristers from the Oakville Children's Choir.

The symphony includes about 70 musicians ranging in age from nine to 19. The Halton Youth Symphony Orchestra is the senior-orchestra of the group, which plays a full range of instruments, while the Halton Youth Chamber Orchestra is a string orchestra ranging in age from eight to 14. This will be the first concert for many of the young musicians.

The grand finale of the concert will see singers from the Oakville Children's Choir join the musicians and lead the audience in a session of Christmas carols.

The Halton Youth Symphony is currently looking for qualified musicians who play viola, cello and string bass.
