Residents looking to do something a little different next Friday night are invited to check out the latest performance in the JustMiltonFolks concert series.

Starting at 8 p.m. at Hugh Foster Hall, 43 Brown St., singer and songwriter Gregg Lawless will perform his unique brand of folk music. Doors will open at 7:30 p.m.

"The best singer/songwriter you've never heard," is how CBC Radio described Mr. Lawless, who has drawn comparisons from James Taylor to Crowded House to David Wilcox.

Mr. Lawless is known for his unconventional career choices. He's self-managed, self-promoted, self-booked, self-produced and self-distributed.

Musical tours have taken him far from the bright lights of the big city to rural Ireland and remote regions of Africa. Rather than spending the past five summers touring or playing music festivals, Mr. Lawless ran songwriting workshops as musical director for Camp Trillium, a camp for children and families affected by childhood cancer.

JustMiltonFolks is a non-profit venture dedicated to bringing Canadian musicians and music with a Canadian identity to Milton, based on the "house concert" format where performers connect with a small audience.
