

Police looking for suspicious salespeople

Police are keeping their eyes open for a suspicious pair of people who were trying to sell alarm systems door to door.

Police received a call around 5 p.m. January 17 from a Knight Trail resident who said a woman had come to the door saying she was selling alarm systems for ADT.

He said the woman then asked to come in and use the phone. She called her boss, who arrived at the house and tried to get in before they both fled. Neither of them had any identification.

Police said ADT doesn't have any door-to-door salespeople. They're asking the public to call them if they spot either of the suspects.

The woman is described as in her early twenties, 'chubby', with black hair tied in a bun.

The man is described as east Indian in his late twenties or early thirties, six feet tall, with a skinny build. He was wearing all black.

The pair left in a silver Buick Rendezvous.

A citizen notified police that a number of vehicles were broken into overnight Monday in the Mowat Lane and Knight Trail area.

Cash and CDs were among the items believed to have been stolen, although no official reports have been taken from the owners.

Tractor-trailer unit stolen

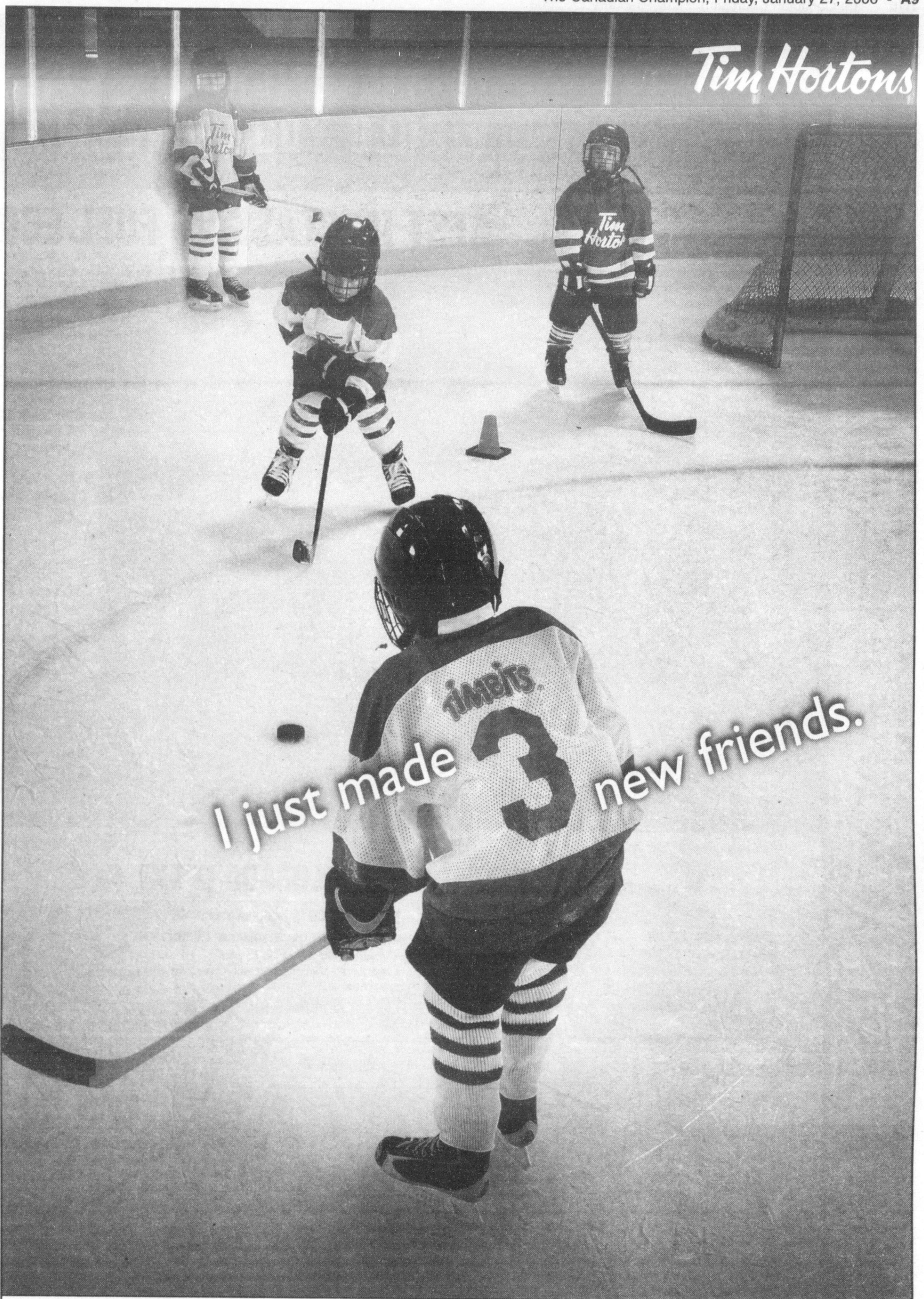
Halton Regional Police are investigating the theft of a tractor-trailer unit in Milton.

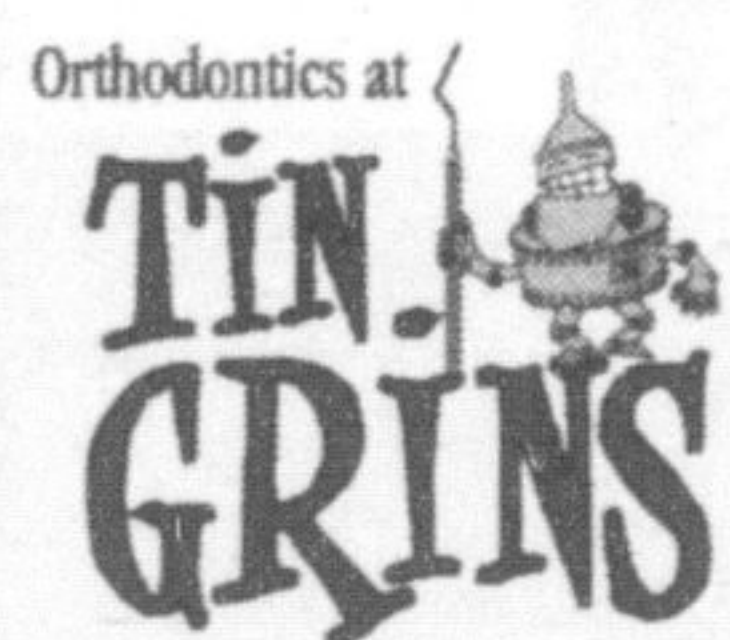
