

Meeting will address school accommodations

Public school board invites residents to review long-term accommodation plan

A plan dealing with the accommodation needs of students in local schools will be the topic of the night at an open house Tuesday evening.

The session, hosted by the Halton District School Board, will be held at Hawthorne Village Public School from 7 to 9 p.m.

Those in attendance will be able to review the board's proposed capital plan, which is a long-term strategy that addresses accommodation requirements of pupils in its elementary and secondary schools.

After the meeting, the public will have the opportunity to give written comments, which will continue to be received until March 9.

Once comments have been reviewed by board staff, an interim report will be prepared and presented to trustees.

A second public meeting will then be held to present the report and any modifications to the proposed capital plan.

Locally, this session will be held April 18 at Hawthorne Village Public School from 7 to 9 p.m.

Following this, the community will once again be able to submit written comments, which will be accepted until May 18.

A final report will be presented to the board in June.




