 from COUNCIL on page A1 that fits in with the neighbourhood.

The design Mr. Sapounzi presented shows a two-storey addition that has a largely stone façade, with the new structure connected to the existing Town Hall with a glass corridor.

Town staff will occupy the new facility, while the current building will become a place for community gatherings.

While residents have questioned the necessity of having Town staff under one roof, Mr. Sapounzi said he thinks it's important, noting it will improve communication between the departments.

Director of Community Services Jennifer Reynolds noted that a civic facilities study previously done recommended the Town Hall should stay in the downtown core, which council approved.

Ward 1 Councillor Rick Day also spoke to the merits of having staff all in the same building, noting a resident could come in to pay their taxes and "give the mayor hell" all in one trip.

To make way for the expansion, council approved the demolition of the former Halton County jail warden's home that's located in the same parking lot as Town Hall and the Planning and Development

department building at 155 King St.

It also supported moving two Mary Street homes to make way for parking, which is expected to be done this spring.

The house at 155 Mary St. will be moved to a Town-owned lot near the corner of Bell and Barton streets and sold as is, and the home at 167 Mary St. will be relocated to a nearby location within the historic downtown neighbourhood, restored and

While work is still being done to finalize the recommended parking situation for the addition, the most recent proposal includes 70 underground spaces and 18 aboveground on the Town Hall property, along with 115 spots across the road in a twostorey parking garage. It's estimated creating this parking will cost a little over \$4 million.

In addition to supporting the schematic design of the Town Hall expansion, council also directed staff to continue providing opportunity for public and stakeholder participation as the project proceeds.






