

Sr. Royals claim consolation crown at All-Catholic Classic

BR gains momentum for semifinal clash with MD

Momentum can be awfully difficult to derail, especially come playoff time.

Bishop Reding's senior basketball team was hoping that popular belief held true heading into today's Halton AA semifinals.

As if closing out the regular season with a nail-biting victory over previously unbeaten Georgetown wasn't enough, the Royals added further steam for their postseason run with a memorable performance at the All-Catholic Classic last weekend in St. Catharines.

Rebounding from an opening-round loss to top-ranked St. Thomas More of Hamilton, Reding reeled off three convincing wins to secure the consolation championship — no small feat for a team that only went into the provincial showcase seeded 16th.

BR's consolation title drive was punctuated with a 58-46 decision over Tecumseh's St. Anne Sunday afternoon. Fortifying their efforts after falling behind by eight early on, the Royals pretty much controlled the last three quarters — thanks in large part to exceptional defence from Marcas Gray and a balanced attack.

Named a tournament all-star for his

stellar overall play, Lee Mathé led consolation championship scoring with 16 points, while Al Alilovic and Sean Mathé also stood out with 14 and 11 points respectively.

Lee Mathé hit double digits in all four weekend games, with his biggest output coming in Saturday morning's 76-56 toppling of Sarnia's St. Patrick's.

He amassed 22 points in that round two triumph, which was particularly impressive since he lost a tooth during nasty-looking second quarter collision.


Lance Codner helped fuel the win with 17 points, while solid contributions from the bench factored into

the decisive win as well.

From there the Royals knocked off St. John's of Brantford 60-40 Saturday afternoon to reach the third-place clash. The Mathé brothers shared the spotlight with 16 points apiece, with 13 and 11 points chipped in by Alilovic and Codner respectively.

Finishing first in Halton's North Division at 9-1, Reding takes on crosstown rival Milton District this afternoon for the right to battle for the AA regional title at Sheridan College Wednesday. Today's game starts at 3:30
