The report, he added, did nothing to allay those fears.

Oakville trustee Alice Anne LeMay said while she doesn't see as many "bogeymen" as other trustees, more focus needs to be placed on exactly "who we are" in future reports.

LeMay also said she spoke at length with Bishop Tonnos, who told her – as he did in the report – that he preferred a stand-alone building and that the board must be wary of any "risks" to Catholicity it might encounter.

Oakville Trustee David Goch said he felt the board is moving too quickly on the campus, to which Superintendent of Business Services and Treasurer Paul McMahon explained work has already been progressing for more than two years.

While not suggesting the board's participation in the campus is a done deal or that no reservations exist, McMahon said the board should proceed with the next phase.

Board Chair Al Bailey said a memorandum of understanding with the other partners will simply not be signed if the board isn't completely satisfied.

"If (the other partners) can't live with what we need, we're not in," he said.
