

# No ECAC title repeat for Gleed

But local blueliner and Cornell still have shot at Frozen Four berth

Milton's Jon Gleed and his Cornell University teammates got schooled on the finer points of powerplay proficiency by their fellow Ivy Leaguers Saturday night.

Unable to stay out of the penalty box early on, the Big Red

fell into a 3-0 first-period hole against Harvard and gave up five goals overall while down a man en route to a 6-2 defeat in ECAC championship play in Albany, New York. The title loss spoiled Cornell's bid for a repeat and marked the fourth time in five years that the two schools had met in the conference final.

"We were pretty undisciplined and they just kept capitalizing," said 22year-old Gleed, a senior defenceman and

year-old Gleed, a senior defenceman and assistant captain with the Big Red — who split a pair of 4-3 games with Harvard in regular-season play. "We drew within one in the second period there, but a weak goal shortly after really deflated us."

He and Cornell reached the ECAC championship with a 2-0 semifinal whitewash of Colgate last Friday evening, but just couldn't stop the Harvard juggernaut that's now scored 24 goals in the last three games and cruised into the final with a 10-1 dismantling of Dartmouth.


The Big Red still have a shot at the national title and will now head to Green Bay, Wisconsin to take on Colorado College tomorrow night in the NCAA Midwest Regional semifinal. If victorious, they'll likely do battle with power-house Wisconsin Sunday for a trip to the Frozen Four April 6 to 8 in Milwaukee. "We've just got to play good, hard hockey and try to stay out of the box. That'll be huge," said Gleed.

Cornell came within a goal of reaching the Frozen Four last spring, losing 2-1 in overtime to Minnesota.
