A copyright, that's what.

So before providing trustees of the Halton District School Board with a shortlist of three potential names for

the new school opening in Milton this fall, board administrators first had to ask the Bruce Trail Association for permission.

The non-profit group owns a copyright on the name of Canada's oldest hiking trail.

That means it has to give prior approval to anyone who wants to use the name.

Board communication services manager Marnie Denton assured trustees during a recent vote on the name of the new school that the nature protection association approves of the board's non-commercial use of the name. A nominal \$2 fee will also be charged to the board.

With the go-ahead cleared, trustees chose Bruce Trail over the other two options, which were Ridgeview and Bridgebrook.

The naming committee established by the board presented Ridgeview because of the prominence of the Niagara Escarpment in Milton. Bridgebrook was chosen for its pleasing aesthetic sound.

A total of 70 potential names were submitted to the committee. Suggestion boxes were placed in area schools and public libraries from December 2005 to February.

Bruce Trail School, at 1199 Costigan Rd., is slated to open in September 2006.

The junior kindergarten to grade 8 school will house 650 students and alleviate overcrowding at Chris Hadfield School.




