Regarding the Halton District School Board's Proposed Capital Plan

The Halton District School Board will hold a second series of public meetings to review the proposed Capital Plan. The Plan is a long-term strategy addressing the accommodation needs of students in Halton's elementary and secondary schools.

The Board held initial public meetings in February in each municipality to seek public input and comments on the proposed Plan. Since those meetings, the public has had the opportunity to submit written comments (until March 9, 2006). The comments have been reviewed by Halton District School Board staff and trustees. An interim report was presented to the trustees of the Halton District School Board at the Accommodation Committee meeting on April 12, 2006.

This interim report will be presented to the public at meetings throughout Halton. This will provide an opportunity to explain modifications to the proposed Capital Plan and to seek feedback.

For the Milton community the public meeting will take place:

Tuesday, April 18, 2006 7-9 p.m. Hawthorne Village Public School (Gym) 850 Bennett Blvd., Milton

After this second public meeting, the community will again have the opportunity to give written comments. Comments will be received until May 18, 2006. It is anticipated a final report will be presented to the Board in June 2006.
