

Teen arrested after vehicle stolen from high school

A young male was arrested Monday morning after police stopped a stolen car.

Police said the car was stopped for a traffic violation around 10:30 a.m. on Williams Avenue in the area of Milton District High School.

The Dodge Neon had been stolen minutes before from the school.

A 17-year-old male was charged with theft under \$5,000 and possession of property obtained by crime.

Lawn ruined

A local resident was charged with mischief in connection with a front lawn that was damaged over the weekend.

Police said Sunday at about 6 a.m., a man drove a 1993 Mercury Villager van over the lawn of a Lower Base Line home, causing \$500 damage.

Vehicles damaged in lot

Police are investigating after an unknown suspect broke into a local business early Sunday morning and damaged two vehicles.

The suspect gained access to the locked and fenced compound of Buckshot Truck Sales Inc. on Steeles Avenue and jumped into an unlocked tow truck, police said. He then drove it into a parked Freightliner truck.

The tow truck sustained about \$4,600 in damage, while the Freightliner was damaged to the tune of \$500.

Stolen car set on fire

A wallet was stolen last week from an unlocked vehicle parked on Martin Street.

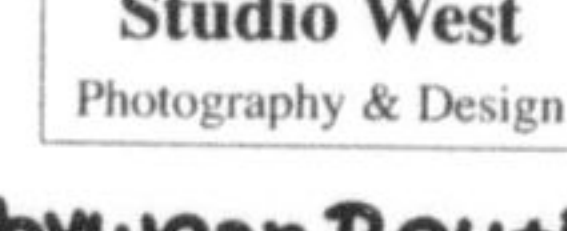
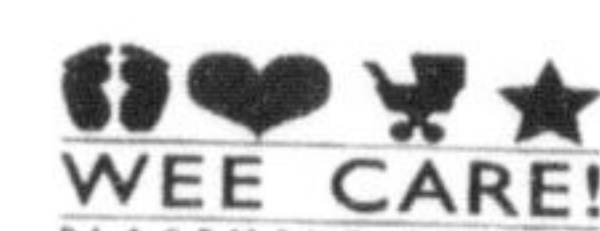

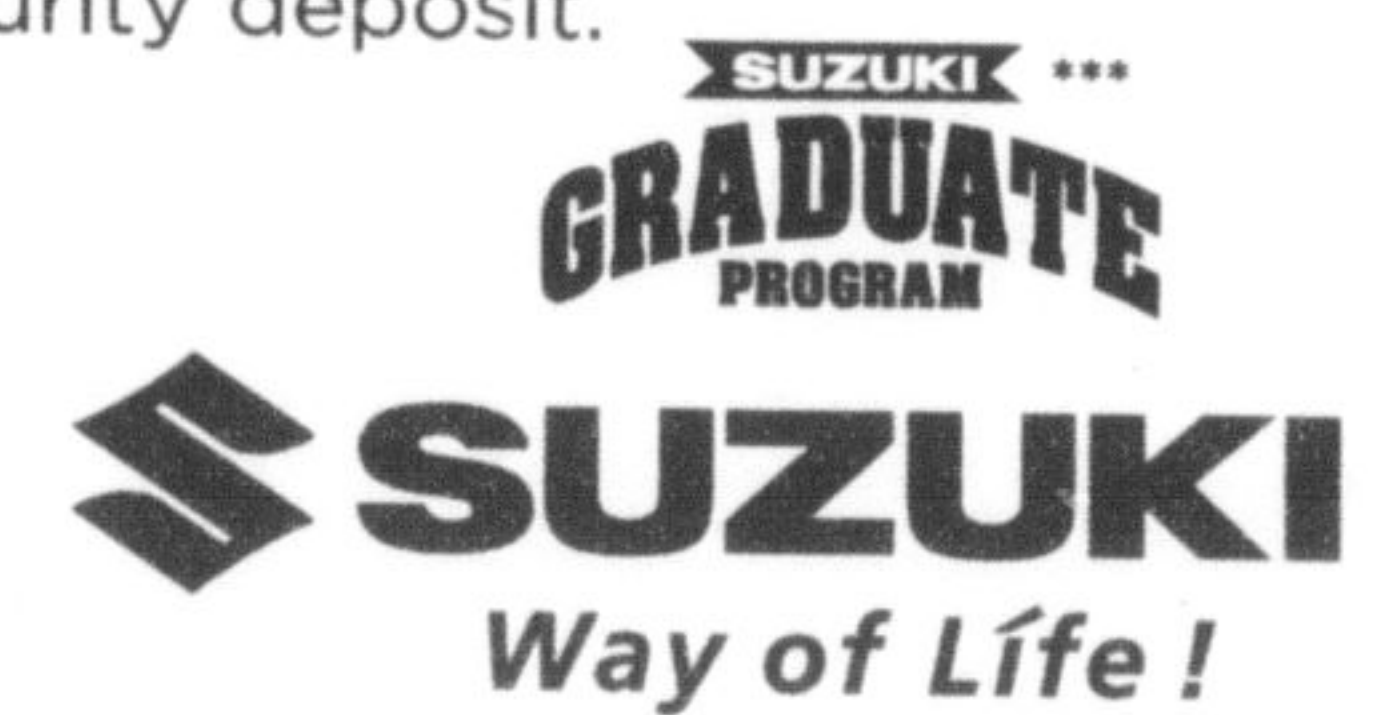
