




PROPOSED CONSTRUCTION OF JAMES SNOW PARKWAY (REGIONAL ROAD 4) FROM WALDIE AVEUNE TO 300 M NORTH OF MAIN STREET TOWN OF MILTON

The Planning and Public Works Committee for the Regional Municipality of Halton proposes at its meeting on **Wednesday, May 24, 2006 at 9:30 a.m.** to recommend to Regional Council at its meeting of **Wednesday, May 31, 2006** to pass a By-law for the construction of James Snow Parkway (Regional Road 4) from Waldie Avenue to 300 m north of Main Street, in the Town of Milton.

Construction drawings showing the proposed work may be reviewed at the Planning & Public Works Department, Halton Regional Centre, 1151 Bronte Road, Oakville.

CONSTRUCTION OF JAMES SNOW PARKWAY (REG. RD. 4)
FROM HWY. 401 TO BRITANNIA ROAD (REG. RD. 6)
AND LOUIS ST. LAURENT BOULEVARD
FROM FOURTH LINE TO JAMES SNOW PARKWAY (REG. RD. 4)
TOWN OF MILTON

Halton Region is planning for the construction of the James Snow Parkway (Reg. Rd. 4) as a 4-lane urban facility between Hwy. 401 and Waldie Avenue and for the initial 2-lane construction (first phase) of an ultimate 4-lane James Snow Parkway (Reg. Rd. 4) between Derry Road (Reg. Rd. 7) and Britannia Road (Reg. Rd. 6) in the Town of Milton. Construction is scheduled to take place in 2006.

The Town of Milton is also planning for the initial 2-lane construction (first phase) of an ultimate 4-lane Louis St. Laurent Boulevard between Fourth Line and the James Snow Parkway (Reg. Rd. 4). Construction is scheduled to take place in 2006.

The James Snow Parkway project followed the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment Process, as a schedule "C" undertaking which involved public consultation and the completion of an Environmental Study Report in March 1999. The Louis St. Laurent Boulevard project is proceeding as a schedule "C" undertaking under the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment Process.

You are invited to attend a joint Public Information Centre to review preliminary and detailed designs for both roadways, provide comment and discuss concerns you may have with representatives from Halton and the Town of Milton. This Public Information Centre will be an informal meeting and you are invited to drop in at your convenience between the noted hours.


