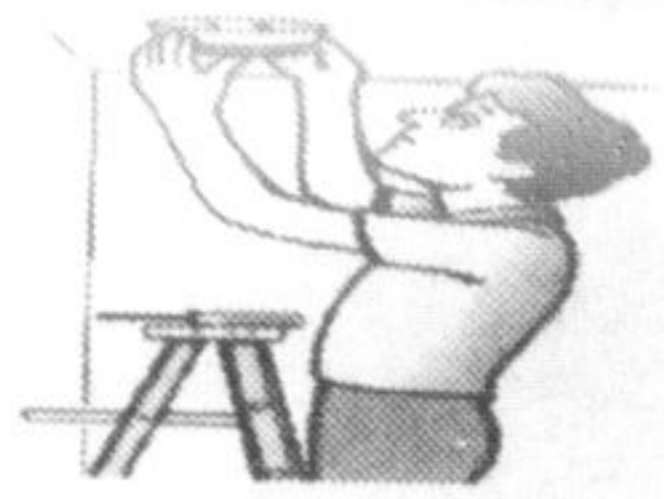

# Baseball Mustangs cement top spot in Volpe

## Bishop Reding still struggling for playoff spot

Milton District's baseball team used equal parts drama and dominance last week to clinch top spot in Halton's Volpe Division.

The latter was delivered at Brian Best Park Wednesday afternoon, when the Mustangs disposed of still winless cross-town rival E.C. Drury 12-3.

Jon Jeysman highlighted the lopsided affair with a homerun, while

Ryan Bauer and Brandon Banaschewski also stood out at the plate with multi-hit efforts. Scott McTrach worked three solid innings on the mound before rookie pitchers Mike Robertson and Brandon Rae Hunt combined for mop-up duty.

It was a much different story two days earlier at Brian Best, where as the host team this time MD scored four

runs in their last at-bat to squeak by Georgetown's Christ the King 10-8.

Bauer hit a two-run double to end the game, while Jason Brooks provided some credible relief work — which was crucial on the day, as McTrach and fellow pitching anchor Chris Shadlock were still sore from rep play and only combined for three innings.

Last week's wins put the Mustangs at 4-1, which gives them first place in Volpe for a second straight season.

Meanwhile, Bishop Reding has struggled since outdistancing MD in week one and now finds itself at 1-3 and still battling for one of the last playoff spots.

The Royals' most heartbreaking loss to date came in Oakville May 8, when they surrendered four seventh-inning runs on five errors and were edged 9-8 by Iroquois Ridge.

Making the narrow loss that much tougher to swallow was the fact that relief pitcher P.J. McColl had shut out the hosts in the fourth, fifth and sixth

— giving BR a great chance to hang on.

At Maplehurst Park Wednesday, the Royals fell behind 11-2 against Loyola and just couldn't dig themselves out of that hole — eventually losing 14-9.

Lee Mathé stood out with a triple, double and walk, while Stephan Gray and Brian Hunter drove in two runs apiece.

To make matters worse for Reding, well-rounded senior Sean Mathé — a reliable pitcher and infielder —

twisted his knee on a run to first last week and could either be out entirely or at less than 100 per cent this week.

The Royals battled Drury yesterday, while both the Royals and Mustangs close out the regular season this afternoon with make-up games from Friday's rainout. Reding is in Georgetown to take on Christ the King and MD hosts Oakville's St. Thomas Aquinas at Brian Best. Both games start at 3:30 p.m.

The playoffs start later this week, with MD having earned a first-round bye.

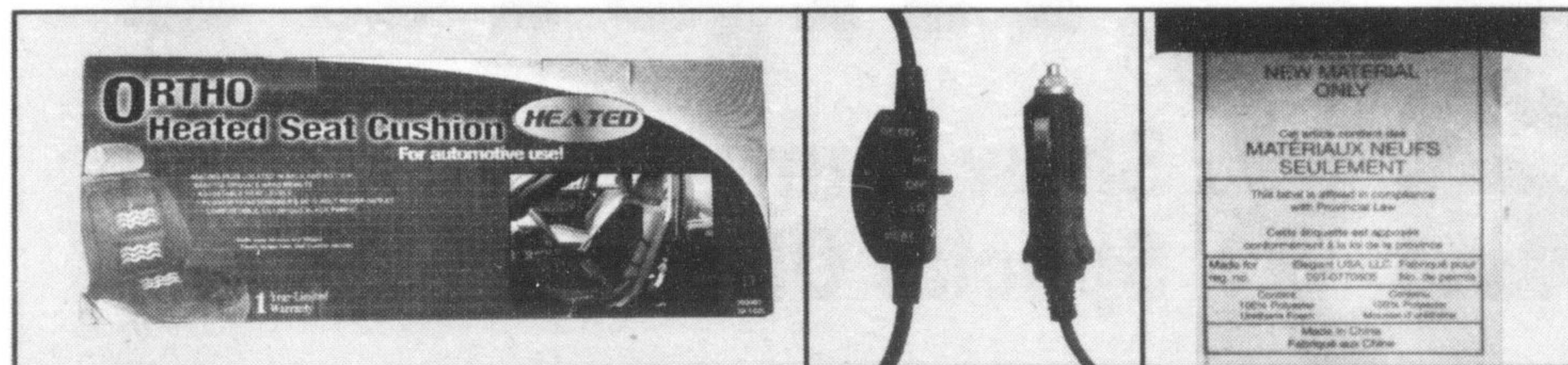
## SAFETY RECALL ELEGANT ORTHO HEATED SEAT CUSHION

It has been determined that a number of units may have a manufacturing defect that can lead to overheating, causing the seat cushion to smoke. To date, there have been 28 reported safety incidents in which the unit overheated, as well as two incidents of injury as a result of this defect. Elegant USA is asking customers to discontinue the use of this product immediately and to return the product to Canadian Tire for a refund.



**How the unit can be identified:**

- Affected units were sold on or after December 1, 2005 and are the Ortho brand only. Seat cushions purchased prior to this date are not affected.
- The Ortho Heated Seat Cushion has a waffle design in the centre of the cushion and a unique remote control.
- It also features a tag that identifies Elegant USA as the manufacturer.
- The cushion is powered by a 12V cigarette adapter only.



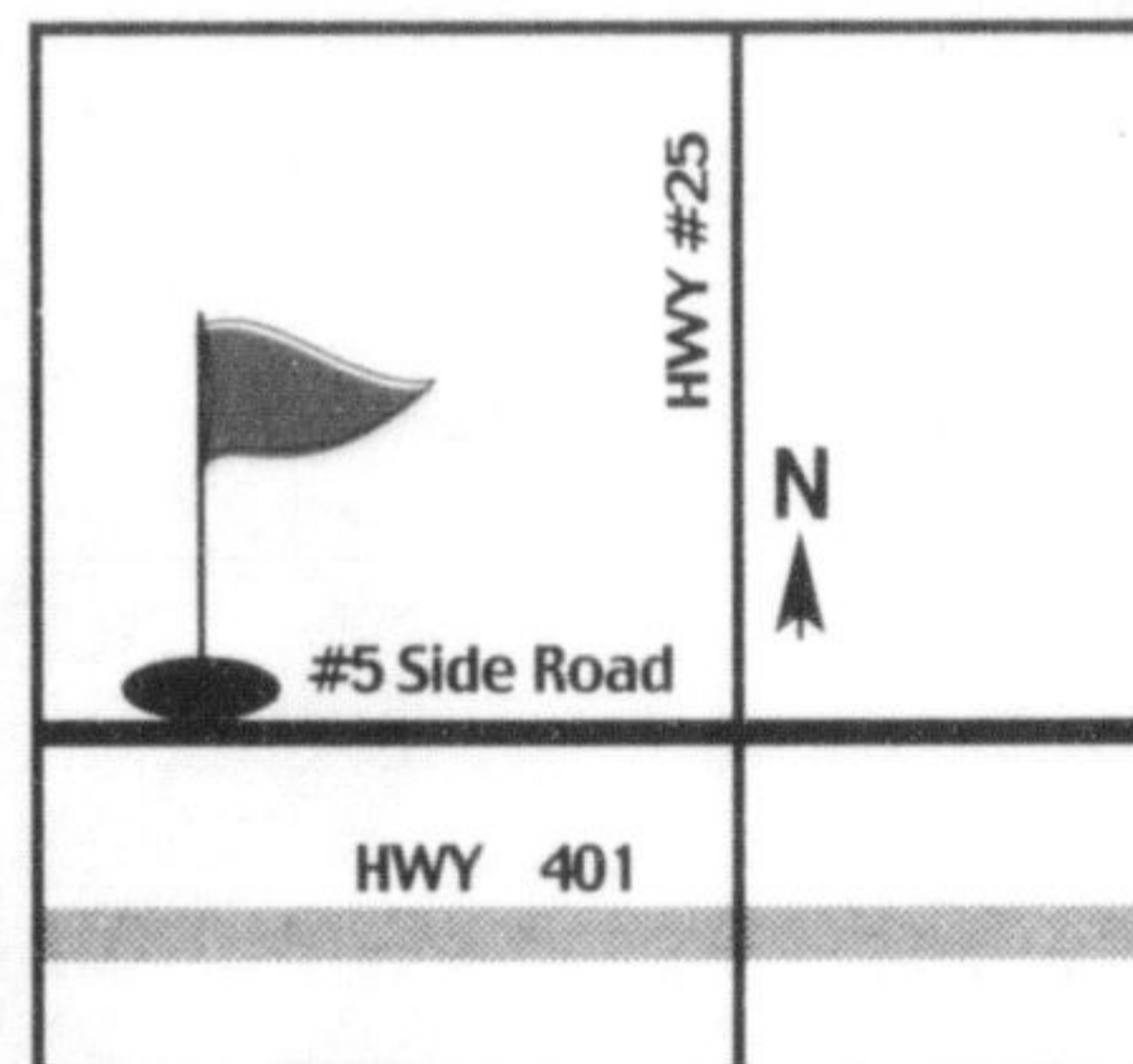
