In the Kennedy Circle and Deacon Drive area, the school board decided to bus students due to heavy construction that left no safe route to walk.

"The construction is now minimal and the children have several options of how they can walk to school," the report notes.

The small group of E.C. Drury students has been bused for the past several years because there was no stop sign or stoplights at Laurier Avenue and Thompson Road. Lights have since been put up.

The board intends to notify each family affected by the change in writing by May 30.

While Tate acknowledged the bus cancellation may cause difficulties for some people, he said he thinks many people will be "just as happy" not having the bus service since the students affected don't live very far from the schools.

The board's transportation policy says bus service will be provided for students in junior kindergarten to grade 5 when they live more than 1.6 km away from their school.

For those in grades 6 to 8, they must live more than 3.2 km away and high school students, more than 4.8 km.
