Drinking From The Well

John Stafford tells about an old well that stood outside the front door of their family farm house in New Hampshire. The water from the well was remarkably pure and cold. No matter how hot the summer or how severe the drought, the well was always a source of refreshment and joy. The faithful old well was a big part of his memories of summer vacations at the farmhouse.

The years passed and eventually the farmhouse was modernized. Wiring brought electric lights, and indoor plumbing brought hot and cold running water. The old well was no longer

needed, so it was sealed for use in possible future emergencies.

One summer day, years later, John Stafford returned to visit the small community he had been raised in. He wanted to allow his wife and kids to understand and appreciate his roots.

As they toured the old homestead, John had a desire for cold, pure water. He unsealed the well and lowered a bucket for a nostalgic taste of the delightful refreshment he remembered. He was shocked to discover that the well that once had survived the severest droughts was bone dry!

He asked local residents why their well had gone dry. He learned that wells of that sort were fed by hundreds of tiny underground rivulets which seep a steady flow of water. As long as the water is drawn out of the well, new water will flow in through the rivulets, keeping them open for more to flow. But when the water stops flowing, the rivulets clog with mud and close up. That is exactly what happened. The well had dried up not because it was used too much, but because it had not been used enough!

The same process can be experienced in believers' lives as well, if they are not careful. The consequence of not drinking deeply of God is to eventually lose the ability to drink at all. Preserve your connection to the refreshing supply of God's love!

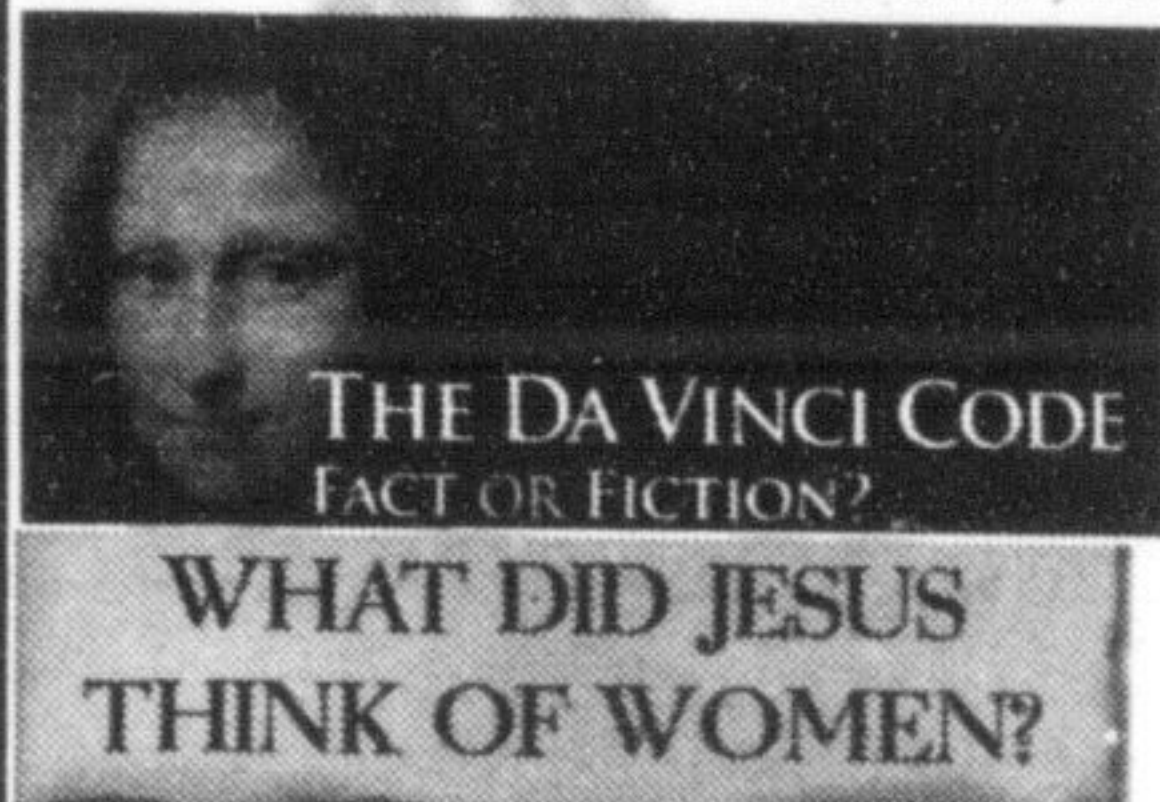

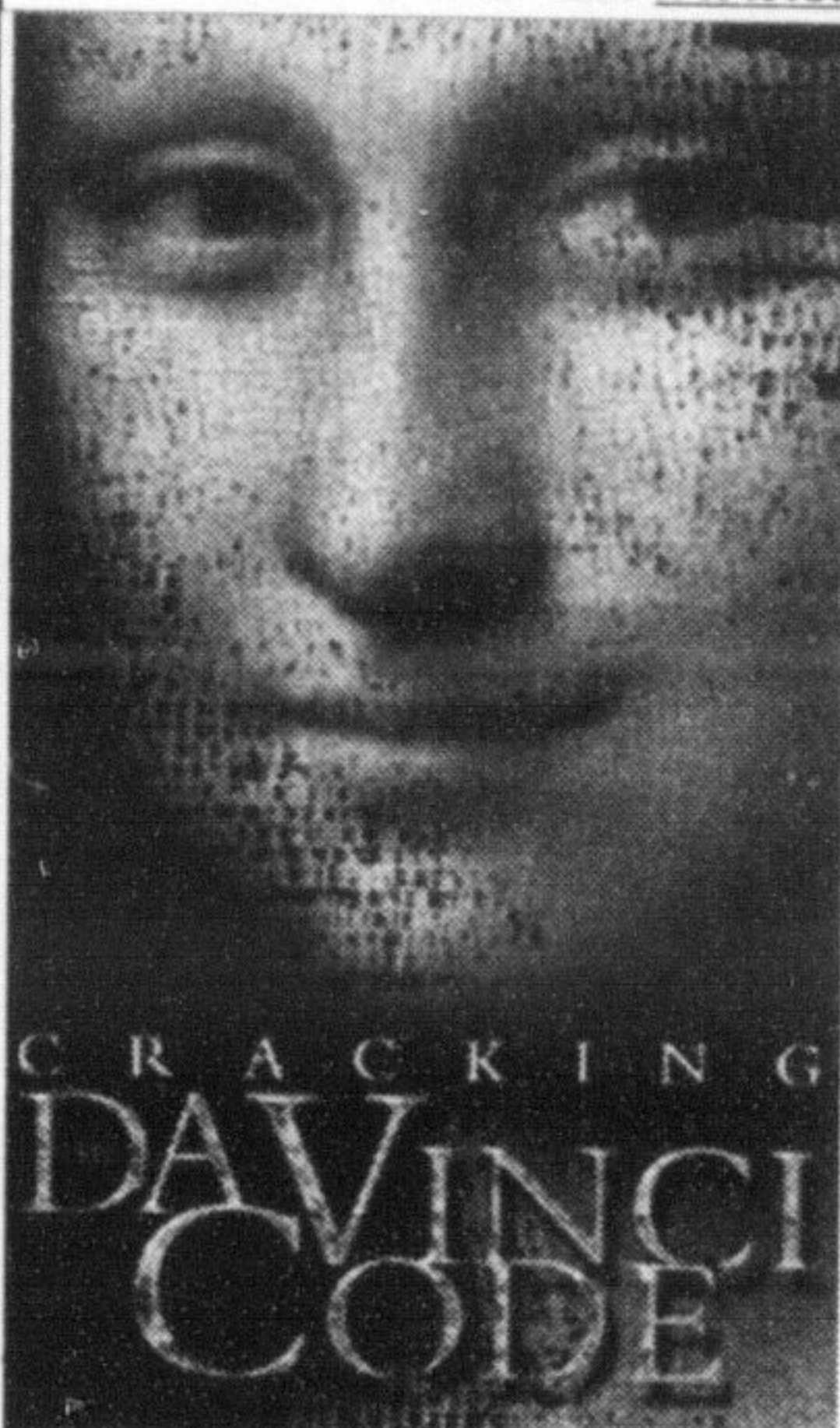
